#### Use Democracy Vouchers to fund your Campaign!

### How the Program Works

In 2025, the Seattle Ethics and Elections Commission (SEEC) will distribute four Democracy Vouchers valued at \$25 each to eligible Seattle residents.

Residents assign vouchers to participating candidates they support. The SEEC verifies the vouchers and issues funds to the campaign.

#### **Become a Candidate**

- Schedule a one-on-one training.
- Pledge to be a Democracy Voucher candidate.
- Collect Democracy Vouchers from Seattle residents.
- Qualify for the program to receive funds.
- Fund your campaign!

#### **Frequently Asked Questions**

#### How much funding is available for campaigns?

For 2025, \$9 million is available for candidates to fund their campaigns.

#### Which positions are eligible for funding?

Mayor, City Attorney, and City Council Positions 2, 8, and 9.

#### How much funding can each candidate get?

Spending Limits for Participating Candidates	City Attorney	City Council At-Large	City Council District	Mayor
Campaign Spending Limits for Primary Election	\$225,000	\$225,000	\$112,500	\$450,000
Combined Campaign Spending Limits for Primary and General Election	\$450,000	\$450,000	\$225,000	\$900,000



### 2025 AT A GLANCE

- January 1, 2024 Election cycle begins.
- January 9, 2025 Candidates must establish Seattle residency by this date.
- February 24, 2025 Democracy Vouchers are mailed and candidates may begin collecting vouchers.
- **May 5-9, 2025** All candidates must file a Declaration of Candidacy with King County Elections.
- **May 23, 2025** This is the last day candidates can pledge to join the Democracy Voucher Program.
- August 5, 2025 Primary Election Day.
- November 4, 2025 General Election Day.
