WHAT ARE DEMOCRACY VOUCHERS?

In 2025, Seattle residents will receive four \$25 vouchers used to support candidates who are running for Mayor, City Attorney, and City Council Positions 2, 8, and 9.

How do I get Democracy Vouchers?

If you are a registered voter in Seattle, you will automatically receive Democracy Vouchers by mail. You **do not** have to be a registered voter to use Democracy Vouchers.

Seattle residents who are at least 18 years of age and are either a U.S. citizen, U.S. national, or lawful permanent resident ("green card holder") may apply to receive vouchers by contacting our office.

Who can I give my Democracy Vouchers to?

You can give one or more Democracy Vouchers to candidates who are participating in the program.
