

## COVID-19 Medical Services Coverage Summary -- Effective May 12, 2023

	<b>Changes Starting May 12, 2023</b>	<b>City-Sponsored Plans</b>
<b>COVID-19 vaccines, including boosters</b>	<p>Members will pay \$0 for the vaccine at in-network locations.</p> <p>It is expected that the COVID-19 vaccine will be added to the standard seasonal vaccine program.</p> <p>Normal plan cost share will apply for out-of-network administration, like the seasonal flu vaccine.</p>	<p>Applies to all Kaiser and Aetna Preventive plans.</p> <p>Vaccines will not be covered on the Aetna Traditional plan.</p>
<b>COVID-19 at-home test kits, also known as over-the-counter (OTC) test kits</b>	<p>Members will pay the retail cost of test kits. They are no longer covered 100%.</p>	<p>This applies to all plans – members will pay the retail cost. (Kits are Health FSA-eligible)</p>
<b>COVID-19 lab tests</b>	<p>Members will pay their copay, coinsurance, or deductible at in-network locations.</p>	<p>Applies to all plans.</p>
<b>Evaluation &amp; Management Visit (E&amp;M) -Telemedicine, Urgent Care, ER and Office Visits Associated with COVID-19 tests</b>	<p>Members will pay their copay, coinsurance or deductible for COVID-19 associated visits (in network and out of network) when there's an associated COVID-19 test done within 2 days before or 2 days after.</p>	<p>Applies to all plans.</p>
<b>COVID-19 anti-viral medications or treatments, like Paxlovid</b>	<p>No change. Members will pay \$0 for these prescriptions while the government supply is available.</p>	<p>Applies to all plans.</p>
