

Eligibility Requirements

Age: Be between 16-24 years old at the start of the program.

Address: Live within the Seattle city limits OR attend a Seattle Public School OR attend North Seattle, South Seattle or Seattle Central College.

Household Income: Live in a household with income at or below 80% Area Median Income.

To receive any compensation for participation, you will need a valid social security number (SSN) or Individual Taxpayer Identification Number (ITIN).

Get paid to attend job readiness trainings while preparing for your career (up to \$325 per module based on attendance).

- Receive support from a Youth Development Counselor (YDC) throughout the program to develop skills and interact in small groups with peers.
