Proposal to add a retractable canvas roof and support beams to the outdoor dining patio, with multiple design options for board consideration. Proposal follows the applicant's January 2, 2025 presentation to the board regarding the outdoor dining patio.

Additional relevant information:

- On January 2 the board reviewed the proposal to retroactively approve the existing structure, which was built by the previous tenant without the required board approval (Certificate of Approval).
- The board declined to approve the proposed structure, citing the heavy collective appearance of the roof beams, the potentially incompatible material of the beams (Glulam), and questions about the roof's degree of transparence or retractability.
- Four options are presented here, ranging from a greater amount of visual impact and usage of Glulam beams (option 1) to the least amount of visual impact and elimination of Glulam beams (option 4).

Guideline Title	Comments
Guideline 3, Scale of Buildings and Structures	Board to determine which, if any, of the proposed options achieve an appropriate balance of size and scale between the structure and its surroundings.
Guideline 4, Building Materials and Fixtures	Board to determine whether the beams are materially compatible within the district, in which natural solid woods are usually preferred.
