Project Description "Women of Jackson Street Jazz" Signal Box Wrap

The Jackson Street Jazz Trail Committee would like to install a vinyl wrap over the signal box on the northwest corner of South Jackson Street and Seventh Avenue South. This would serve as a stop on the Jackson Street Jazz Trail commemorating "The Women of Jackson Street Jazz," a collage of photographs depicting Ernestine Anderson, Patti Bown, Edythe Turnham, Zelma Winslow, Evelyn Williamson, Dee Dee Hackett and Evelyn Bundy-Taylor. The signal box sits on a 4" concrete dais. The box proper is 44" wide, 26" deep and 48" high on the side facing the street and 49 1/2 " high on the side facing the sidewalk. (The top of the box slopes slightly upward from street to sidewalk and also extends 1 1/2" beyond the side facing the sidewalk. The side facing the sidewalk has a door slightly smaller than the sidewalk face, with a hinge on the west side. The wrap would cover all four sides and the top of the box.
