**Use**: Proposed establishment of use for a residential building (66 units) with ground floor commercial space (1,356 sq ft).

**Demolition and Final Design**: Proposed demolition of the existing single-story commercial building and proposed final design for new construction of an 8-story mixed use apartment building with ground floor commercial space. The proposal includes landscaping along 5<sup>th</sup> Ave S. and regrading a portion of the alley. No parking is proposed.
