032625.11 Market Grill

Right-of-way adjacent to: 1509 Pike PI #3 Applicant: Drew Zarba, Business Owner Property Owner: Shannon Hilliard, PDA Use: Proposal to operate a temporary outdoor dining area for the exclusive use of Market Grill customers.

Staff Report: Minh Chau Le provided exhibits related to proposal: Site plan, floor plan, photo of site, and photos and details for stanchions, tables, chairs, umbrellas. Relevant guidelines cited 2.8.1, 2.9.1, 2.11.4. URC recommendation: Approval

URC: Consistent with what was approved previously.

Applicant Presentation & Comment: Repeating seating done in past, exactly as done before.

Property Owner Comment: Approves.

Public Comment: None.

Commission Questions: None.

Commission Discussion: None.

Action: Sarah Baker made a motion to adopt a resolution to accept application as presented, citing 2.8.1, 2.9.1, 2.11.4.

Vote: 6:0:0 Motion carried.

Design: Proposal for seating, umbrellas, stanchions related to outdoor dining operation.

Staff Report: See above Staff Report for exhibits. Relevant guidelines cited 3.4; 3.6; 3.7; 3.8. No conflicts cited.

DRC: Red umbrellas preferred by DRC; DRC requested signs that note priority seating for Market Grill customers.

Applicant Presentation & Comment: Prefers rope dividers; sign on tables will face up rather than outwards.

Property Owner Comment: No comment

Commission Discussion: Whether the signs should refer to priority vs exclusive seating. Straw poll taken to make signage optional 3/2/1. Applicant agrees with either exclusive or priority; both are acceptable.

1516 Western Ave Sarah Meranda, Business Owner Shannon Hilliard, Property Owner

Placement of an A-frame sign in the right-of-way adjacent to the business space.

Staff Report: Minh Chau Le provided exhibits related to proposal: Site plan; existing floor plan; photos of existing A-frame location, proposed A-frame sign design; awning sign details. Relevant guidelines cited 3.6.6.

UCR: Recommended approval. Awning has had printed signs for previous and neighbor tenants.

Applicant Presentation & Comment: The shop has limited space for signage.

Property Owner Comment: There are unique limitations and visibility challenges for the site.

Commission Questions: Confirms that applicant is amenable to using these signs on a temporary basis until a permanent design is ready.

Staff Report: Minh Chau Le provided exhibits related to proposal 032625.13: Renderings; color and material information; scale drawings; mounting details; site plan. Relevant guidelines cited: 3.6.6. URC recommendation: Approval.

UCR: Recommended approval. Appreciated attention to site lines, context to other signs.

Applicant Presentation & Comment: Usefulness of directional signage at this location for customers and delivery, visually appealing.

1901 Western Ave Plaza Level, MarketFront Building; 1501 Pike Pl, Level 3 outdoor area, Leland Building; Right-of-way: Pike St at 1st Ave; Right-of-way: Pike Pl between Pike St and Virginia St.

Applicant and Property Owner: Zack Cook, PDA

Use: Proposal for outdoor public seating at various Market locations.

Staff Report: Minh Chau Le provided exhibits related to proposal 032625.14: Applicant's statements; site plans; photos of proposed sites; photos and details for stanchions, tables, chairs, umbrellas. Relevant guidelines cited 2.3, 2.9, 2.11.

UCR: Consolidated application is helpful. Recommended approval.

Applicant & Property Presentation & Comment: Location descriptions, dimensions, consideration had been made regarding busker spaces, activation, loading/unloading considerations. The Down Under space is a new location for seating. Planters will serve as barriers.

Commission Questions: Confirmation of: timeline for Pike PI seating is coordinated with the Copacabana deck replacement, SDOT involvement with applications; working with tenants; management of seating areas; public, non-exclusive seating.

Commission Discussion: True public seating; potential new seating trends from park reopening.

Action: Grace Leong moved to adopt a resolution approving the application as amended to allow seating at MarketFront and HillClimb allowed for one full year from now, citing 2.3. 2.9, 2.11.

Vote: 6:0:1 Motion carried. Abstention by Lisa Martin

Design: Seating, umbrellas, barriers, fencing, signage related to outdoor seating areas.

Staff Report: Minh Chau Le reports DRC request for floor plan for HillClimb area and signage. Relevant guidelines cited 3.1; 3.6; 3.6.6; 3.7; 3.8.

DCR: Floor plan and signage was provided upon request; concerns with mobile items and safety for drop to Western Ave.

Applicant and Property Owner Presentation & Comment: Zack Cook, PDA: Wayfinding signage was provided at the DRC's request.

Public Comment: None

Commission Questions: Accessible electricity; signage.

Commission Discussion: General support; general future contemplations of space. Jon Cracolici moved to adopt a resolution to approve the application as presented, citing 3.1; 3.6; 3.6.6; 3.7; 3.8.

Market Information Booth – Pike St between 1st Ave and Pike Pl

Applicant: Rudd Schupp, Visit Seattle Property Owner: Shannon Hilliard, PDA

Proposal to install additional brochure racks on information booth.

Staff Report: Minh Chau Le provided exhibits related to proposal 032625.21: Photos of site; rack and hardware images; site plans. Relevant guidelines cited 3.1; 3.4.1; 3.4.3; 3.8. DRC recommendation: Approved.

DCR: Straightforward proposal.

Applicant Presentation & Comment: Materials to be displayed by day only.

Property Owner Comment: Supports proposal.

Public Comment: None.

Commission Questions: None.

Commission Discussion: Suggestion to allow the ability to add racks of the same design if needed in the future so they don't have to return to MHC.

Action: Jon Cracolici moved to adopt a resolution approving the application with the following amendment: applicants may replace the existing rack to match or add racks along that frontage as needed, citing guidelines 3.1; 3.4; 3.8.

032625.22 North Arcade Slabs

1509 Pike Pl, outdoor concrete slabs north of the Fairley Building North Arcade Applicant and Property Owner: Zack Cook and Alana Crowley, PDA

Proposal to permanently install vertical display grids onto the existing horizontal concrete slabs used for vending

Staff Report: Minh Chau Le provided exhibits related to proposal 032625.22: Project overview; applicant's data on past grid usage; grid specifications; photos of existing slabs; photos of installed grids. Relevant guidelines cited 2.1; 2.11; 3.2; 3.4; 3.8. DRC recommendation: Use should be incorporated into the discussion.

DCR: Requires further conversation, including consideration of use guidelines.

Applicant & Property Owner Presentation & Comment: Presented exhibits, discussed falling hazards.

Public Comment: Gina Caraba; Kim Ramirez; Daniel Flemming; Mark Carpenter; John Paulson; Heather Pihl; Peter Shively; Ryan Sanderson; Austin Crowley.

Commission Questions: Confirmation of: survey sample size of 27; grid install/removal; fabricated in 2016; load strength of grids not adequate for total safety.

Commission Discussion: Consider additional brackets to join grids to one another. In favor of safety. The proposal is not a permanent solution. Applicant should work with MHC to design a more permanent display and safety grid.

Action: Jon Cracolici made a motion to approve the application with following amendments: removable temporary brackets to be installed to improve their strength, the approval lasts 12 months from today, citing 2.1; 2.9; 2.11; 3.2; 3.4; 3.8.

Vote: 6:1:0 Motion carried. Lisa Martin opposed.
