

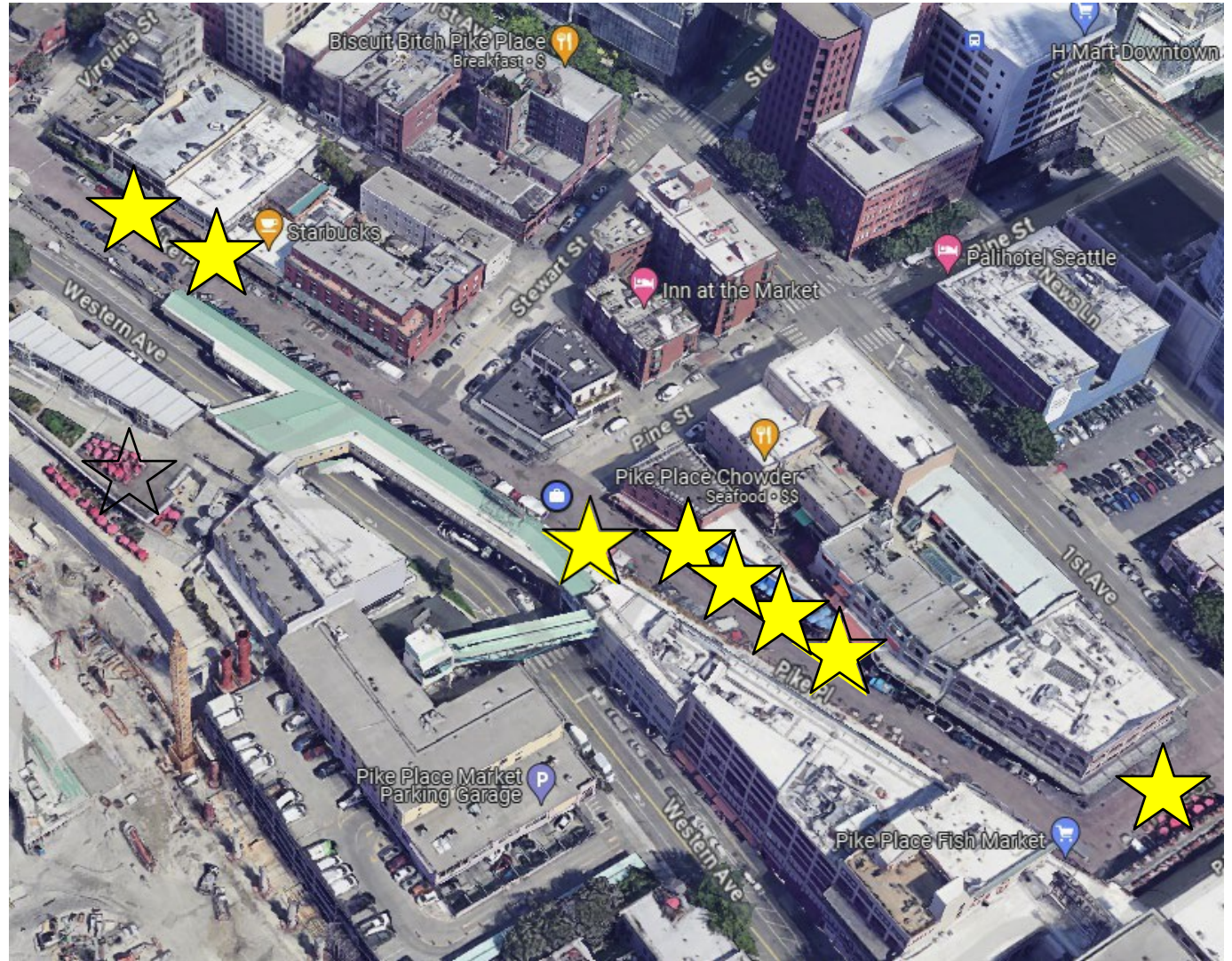
# Pike Place Market Outdoor Seating Plan

# 2026 Application

- The PDA is requesting approval to manage public seating at the locations indicated on the adjacent map.
- In 2026, the PDA is once again submitting one permit application for all locations indicated.
- All seating included in this proposal will be open to all Market visitors and not reserved for any individual businesses.\*
- PDA has worked closely with Market tenants and stakeholders to present this proposal
- Seating Program would operate from approximately May 22 through the end of October.

\*Market Grill is not included in this proposal and will submit a permit application for outdoor dining. This business has received MHC approval for outdoor dining annually for over 10 years.



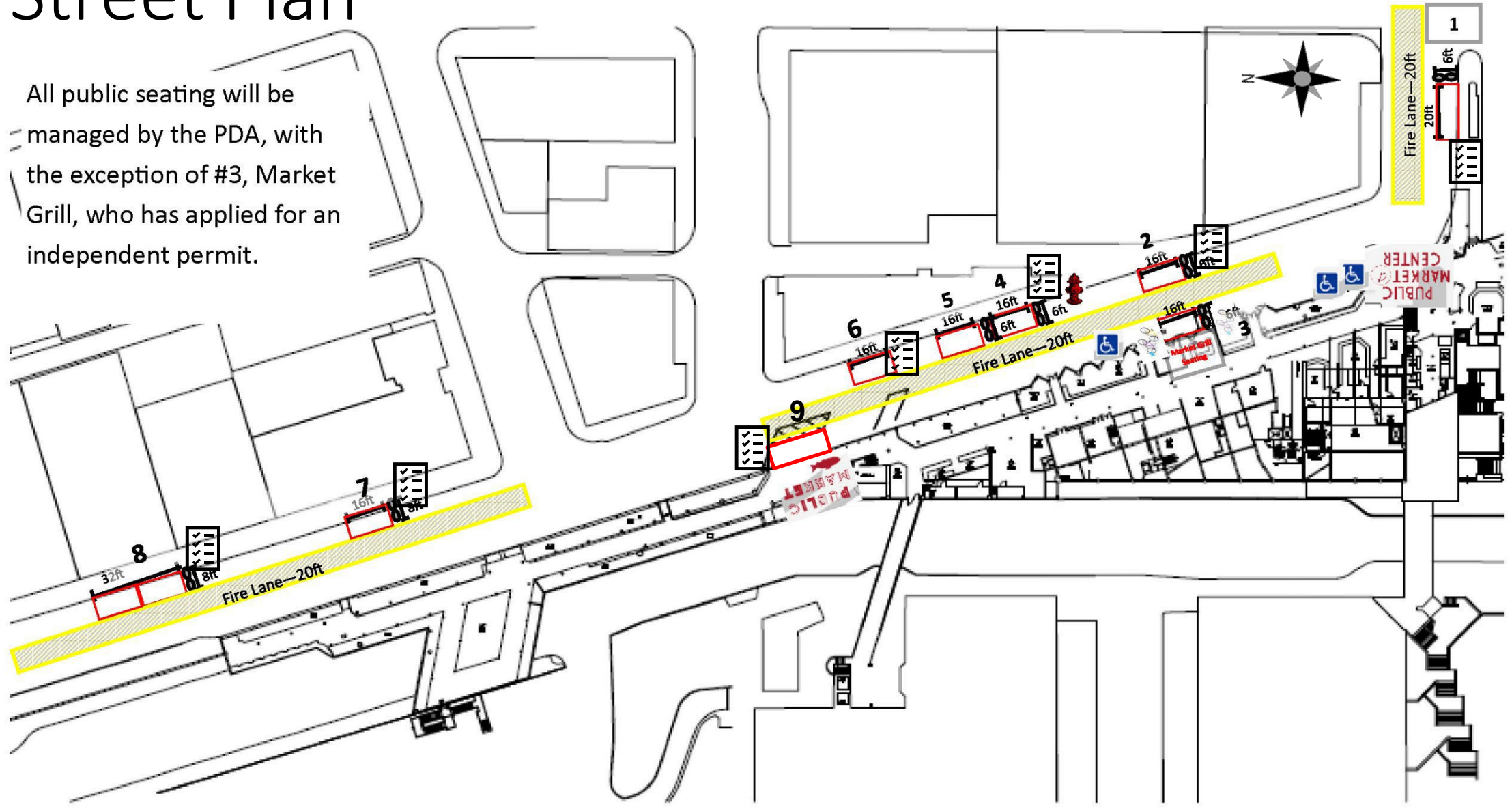


# Considerations

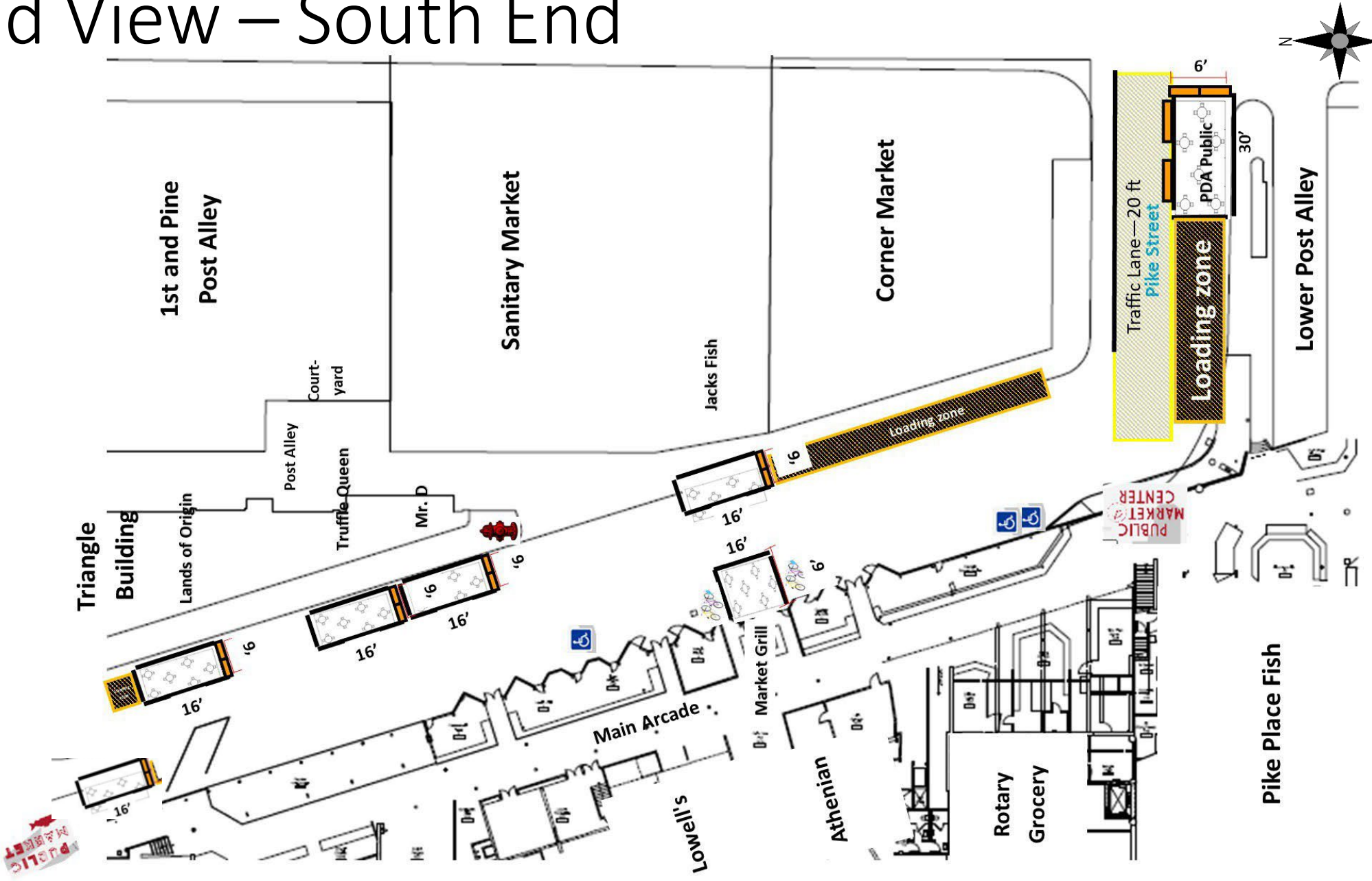
- Providing access and space for Market farmers is our priority. No farmers are being displaced in providing outdoor dining along Pike Place.
- PDA staff are working closely with farmers to ensure they have access to load/unload areas during key times.
- Access to tables is open to anyone!

# Full Street Plan

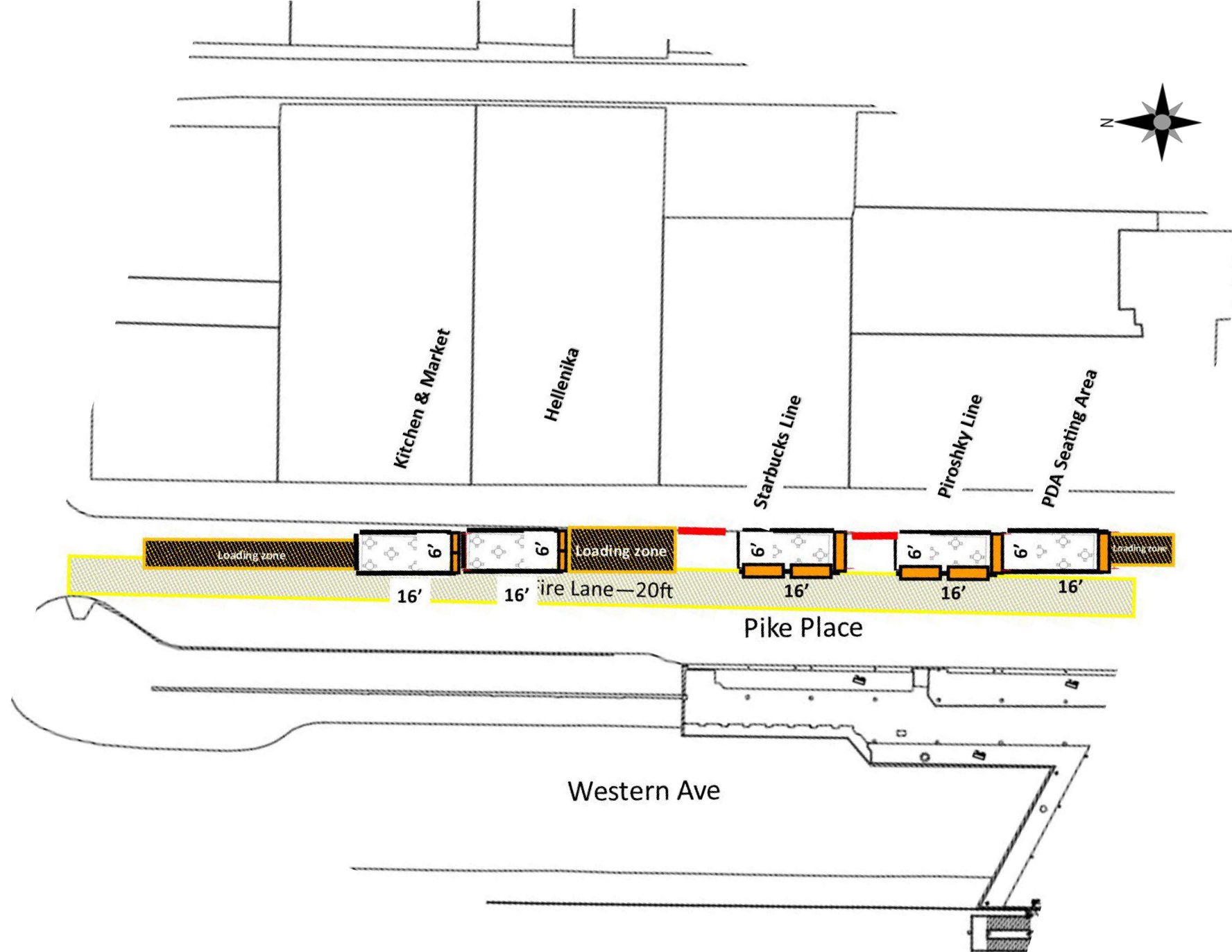
All public seating will be managed by the PDA, with the exception of #3, Market Grill, who has applied for an independent permit.

## Umbrellas

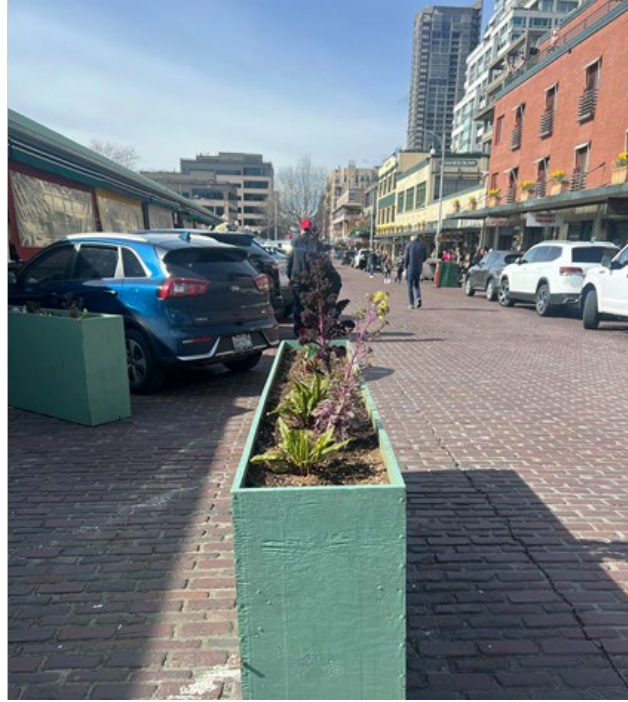
- 9' dia. Fabric umbrella(red) with crank/tilt steel pole(black)

- Sizes 72" x 60" including built-in benches.
- Sealed southern yellow pine

- Size: 6'W x 2'D x 72" tall

- Fencing:
- Material: PVC with UV inhibitors
- Length 72", Height 42"
- Color: White

- A-frame signs located at outside of all seating areas
