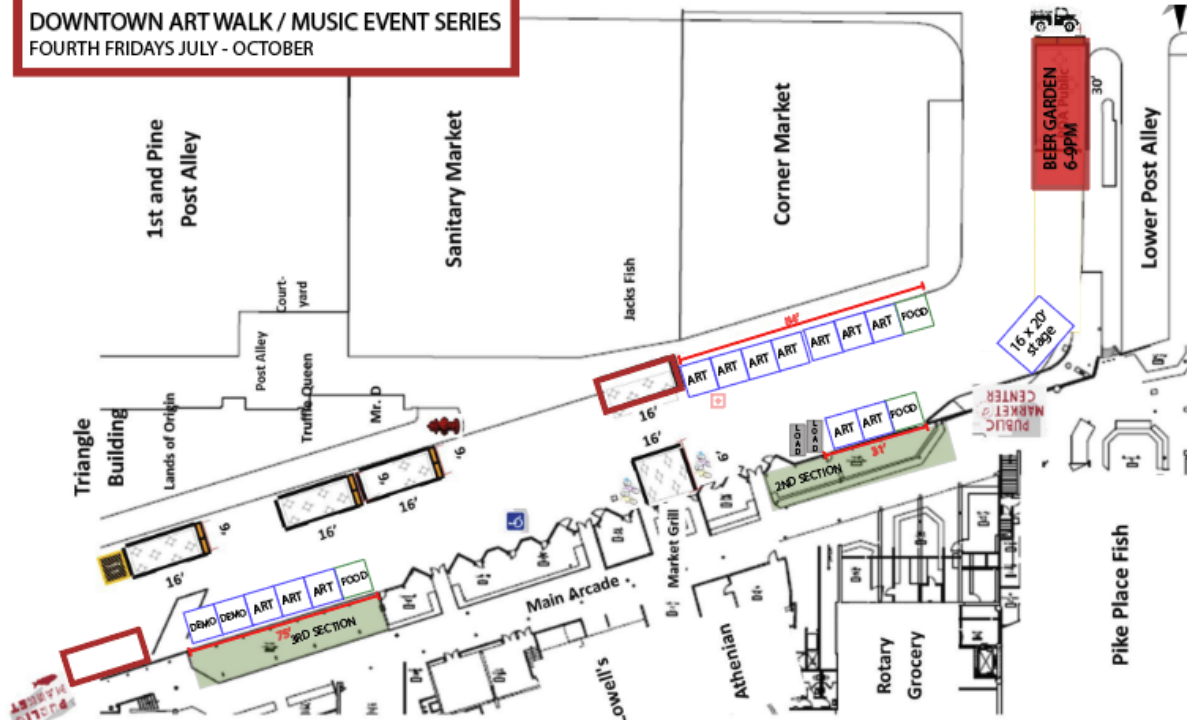

# Lighting Plan



## Temporary Event Lighting

Temporary event lighting will be used primarily to illuminate performers and stage activity during evening hours.

- Standard white stage/event lighting
- No permanent fixtures proposed
- No building-mounted lighting
- Used during evening performance hours only

## No Permanent Alterations

All lighting equipment is fully portable and will be removed after each event. No fixtures will be attached to any historic structure or surface.

# Amplified Sound Management



## Sound Overview

Amplified sound will be utilized as part of the DJ and live music performances. Sound levels will be managed by on-site event staff and are intended to be consistent with temporary outdoor community music programming and other previously permitted Market events.

## Sound Management Commitments

- Dedicated event staff will monitor and manage sound levels throughout all programming
- Sound levels consistent with other permitted Market events and temporary outdoor music programming
- All amplified sound equipment is portable and will be removed after each event

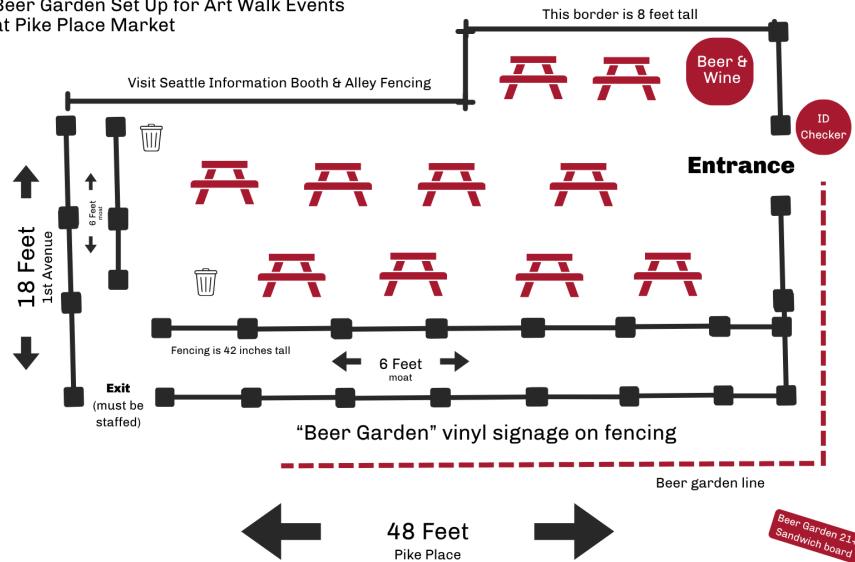


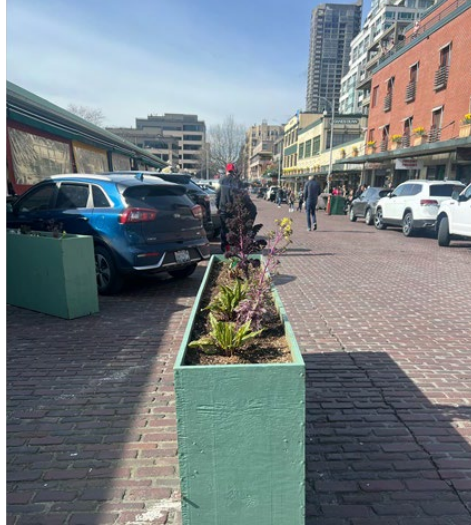
## Rabbit Box

# Historic Preservation Compliance

- **Fully Temporary Infrastructure**

The stage, lighting, sound equipment, and all associated event infrastructure are temporary in nature and portable.

- **No Permanent Alterations**

No permanent alterations, attachments, or modifications will be made to any historic structures, surfaces, or fixtures within the Market district.

- **Consistent with Market Use**

The event is consistent with temporary use provisions under the Pike Place Market Historical Commission's Use, Design, and Development Guidelines (Section 2.9).

- **Established Precedent**

The stage location has been used for prior permitted events.
