Plan Set for Occidental Roller Rink

Survey of Current Conditions

The Downtown Seattle Association (DSA) is currently under contract with Seattle Parks and Recreation to manage and activate Occidental Square Park. In accordance with that agreement one of the ways DSA is tasked with is managing and activating the space for public use and enjoyment. Current conditions are light and underused. As part of All Star Game Week programming DSA is proposing to bring a roller rink for free public use for a limited duration of time (Installation on July 8th with removal on July 15th).

Proposed Installation Dimensions

Footprint for proposed roller rink installation includes a 40 ft x 80 ft roller rink with a temporary 8 ft x 8 ft storage shed.








Fencing

Roller Rink Location at Occidental



There are no attachments to the ground. The roller rink will sit on plywood sheeting as to not harm the bricks in the park.

Most of the rink is black and white.

Ambient and stage quality lighting for the rink is being brought in. That will be turned off when the rink shuts down for the night (6:00 PM).

There is no signage for the roller rink company. There are sponsorship banners that DSA will be hanging. The creative for this has not been completed and is pending HPB approval of the roller rink. Will file separate application.

Public bathrooms will be in the park for some days to support other programming.
