Repaving and striping the parking lot and installation of new lighting

Staff report: The changes to the parking lot appear not have a significant change to the appearance except for the lighting. The lighting is shorter and pointed down and may be an added benefit to the residential buildings surrounding the parking lot.

Draft Motion:

I move to recommend granting a Certificate of Approval for Repaving and striping the parking lot and installation of new lighting. All per the applicant's submittal.

The Board directs staff to prepare a written recommendation of approval based on considering the application submittal and Board discussion at the December 18, 2024 public meeting and forward this written recommendation to the Department of Neighborhoods Director.

23.66.030 Certificates of Approval required

Certificate of approval required. No person shall alter, demolish, construct, reconstruct, restore, remodel, make any visible change to the exterior appearance of any structure, or to the public rights-of-way or other public spaces in a special review

district, and no one shall remove or substantially alter any existing sign or erect or place any new sign or change the principal use of any building, or any portion of a building, structure or lot in a special review district, and no permit for such activity shall be issued unless a certificate of approval has been issued by the Department of Neighborhoods Director.
