


### **Door Location: Main Entry Doors in Courtyard**

We propose to furnish and install two new powder coated hollow metal doors with upper and lower lite kits (1/4" clear laminated glass). New hardware will include eight hinges, one full length steel out swinging astragal (active door), one electrified concealed vertical rod panic bar (active door), two concealed flush bolts (inactive door), one offset pull handle (active door), one wire loop, one automatic operator, two push buttons, two transmitters, one receiver and one time delay module (active door). Once the installation is complete, we will adjust all for the best possible operation.

Customer to get 120v power to the doors.

The lead time will be determined at the time of approval.

We will remove and dispose of the materials being replaced.

The materials installed will be covered by the manufactures warranty, if applicable.

No electrical wiring to be done by Davis Door Service.


