The process for considering this request includes hearings before an advisory committee composed of neighbors and School District and City representatives. The Committee can recommend departures and any relevant conditions to be applied to minimize their impacts or recommend denial. The Committee may make its recommendation following this meeting or hold up to two additional meetings prior to making its recommendation.
