
Northwest Hospital surveys patients in the hospital and ambulatory settings to assess service levels.

We have been surveying to improve service performance under the UW Medicine Patients are First program since 2011.




#### **HOSPITAL OVERALL RATING**

#### **COMMUNICATION WITH NURSES**


### Percentage of patients answering "nurses <u>always</u> communicated well."

## Percentage of patients answering "Yes, they would definitely recommend"




#### **OUTCOMES**

#### **AMBULATORY HIGHLIGHTS**

- ➤ Transitioned 13 clinics into the Ambulatory Clinic Network
- > Recruited and hired new providers
- ➤ Consistently met service excellence goals and remain system-wide leader in willingness to recommend, physician communication and overall physician rating
- ➤ Increased access by providing evening and weekend hours in our Primary Care clinics

- ➤ Formerly Puget Sound Hearing & Balance
- ➤ Board-certified otolaryngologist, subspecialties in otology and neurotology; staff of audiologists.
- ➤ Chronic ear infections, acoustic tumors, Meniere's disease, cochlear implants, bone-anchored hearing aids, hearing tests, surgical procedures such as ear drum repair.



  - The Sports Medicine Clinic and Advanced Manual Therapy relocated from former Ballard location
  - New UW Neighborhood Ballard Clinic opened
- ➤ Mid 2015
  - UW Medicine Urgent Care opened
- ➤ Late 2015 2016
  - Medical specialists providing care at Ballard location –
     OB/GYN, hip & knee, cardiology


