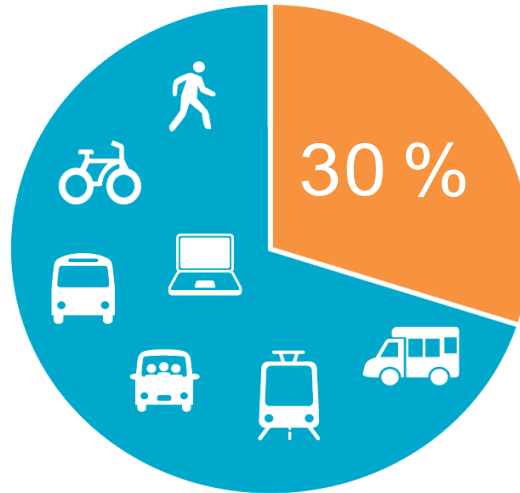

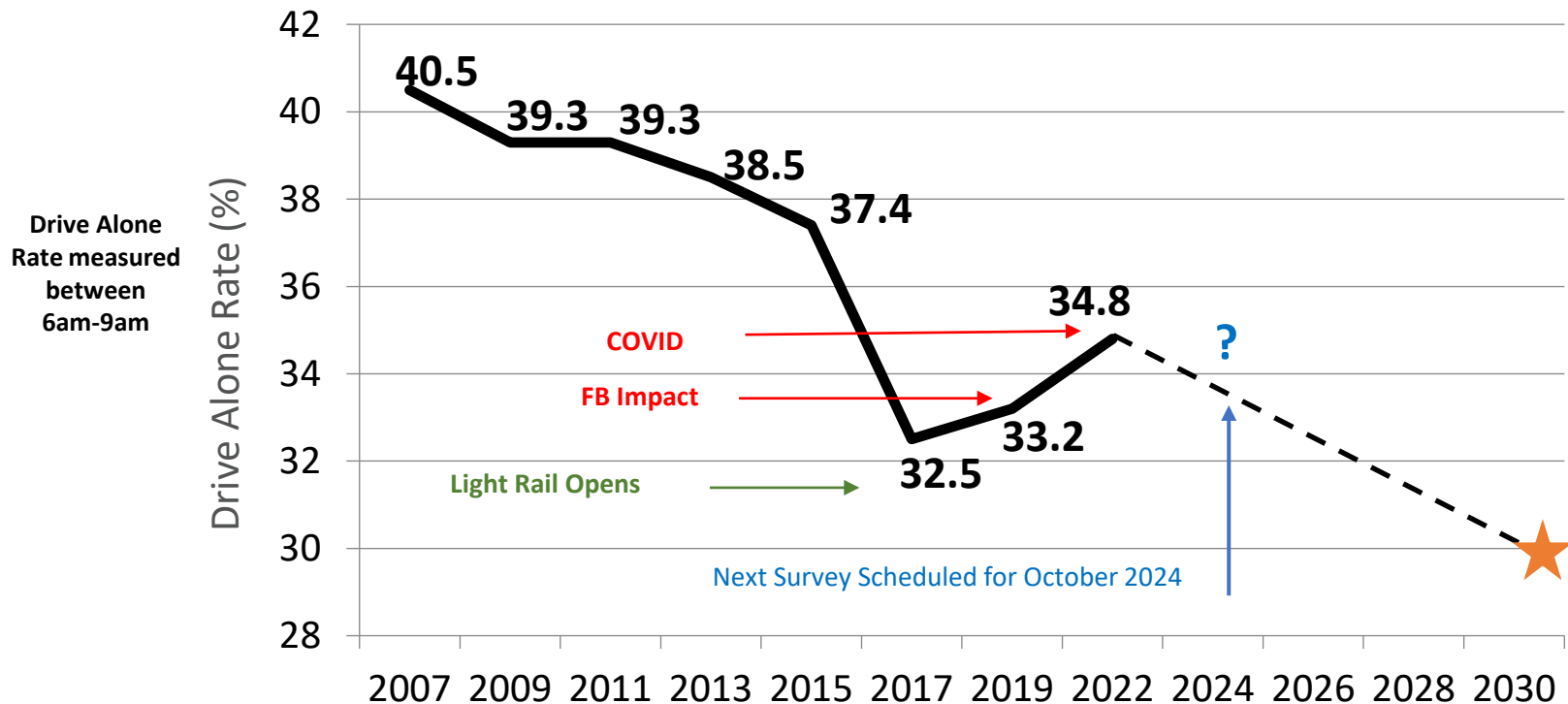


Transportation Overview

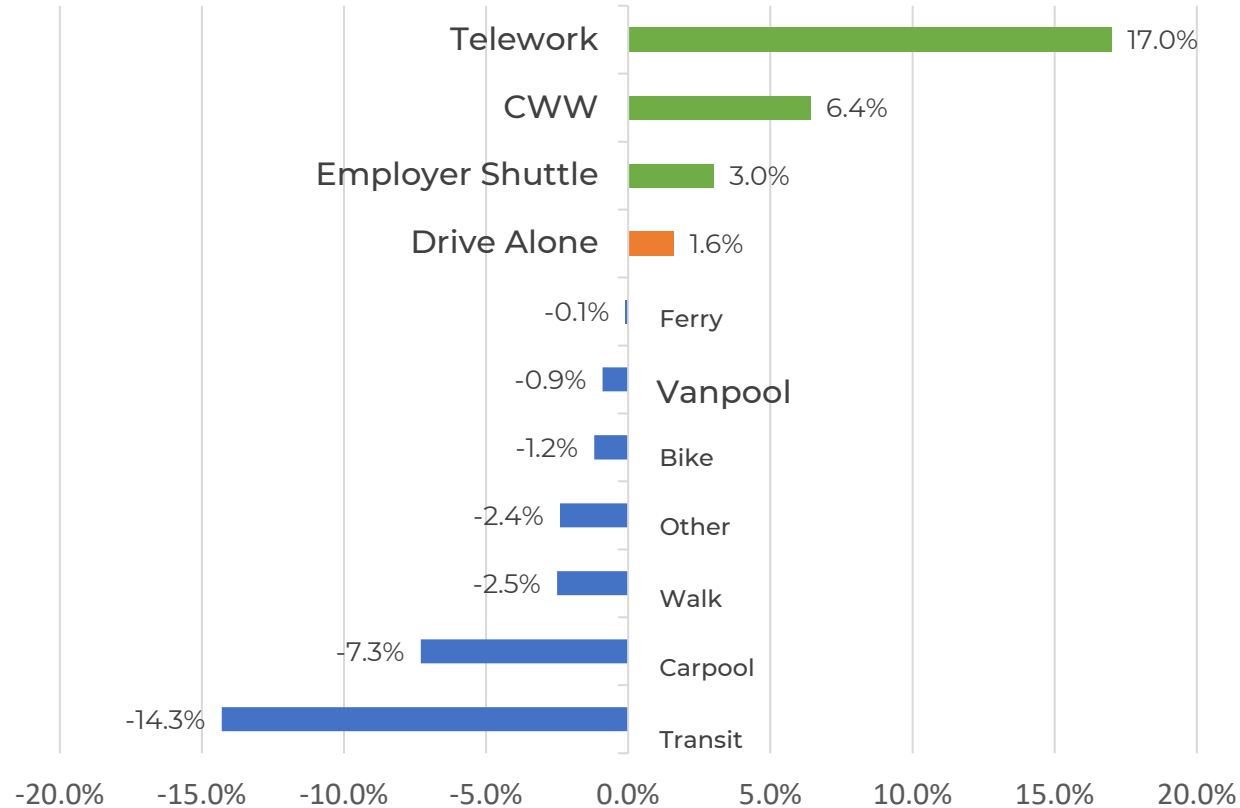
- Achieve a 30% Drive Alone Rate (DAR) mode split, at complete build out
- Achieve this through application of policies, programs, incentives
- Conduct a Commute Trip Reduction (CTR) Survey every two years to benchmark progress

2023 Annual Report Highlights

March 2023 Federal and State Covid Mandates Lifted

- Transitional period to determine new normal

Strengthen Programs

- Maintained robust telework/remote work program
 - Formal shift to remote work for administrative positions; remote 3 days/wk
 - Shifted other administrative staff from hospital to locations downtown
- Resumed parking rates consistent with MIMP requirements
- Maintained free ORCA transit pass to encourage transit use
- Children's Shuttle system remains adaptive
 - Dynamic demand so constantly right sizing
 - Purple Line to the U-District replaced Metro's route 31/32



Street Parking Enforcement

- Street parking not permitted in neighborhoods surrounding the hospital campus
- Frequent standard reminders announcements to leaders and workforce
- Conduct multiple standard parking enforcement patrols per week
- Targeted response to “hot spots” submitted to Construction@SeattleChildrens.org
- Vehicle data collected in field by photo and cross referenced in-office
 - Tickets are applied through email and electronically
- Average 2-3 citations a day
- Note: Many workforce members live in the neighborhood

Sound Transit: Link Light Rail Expansion

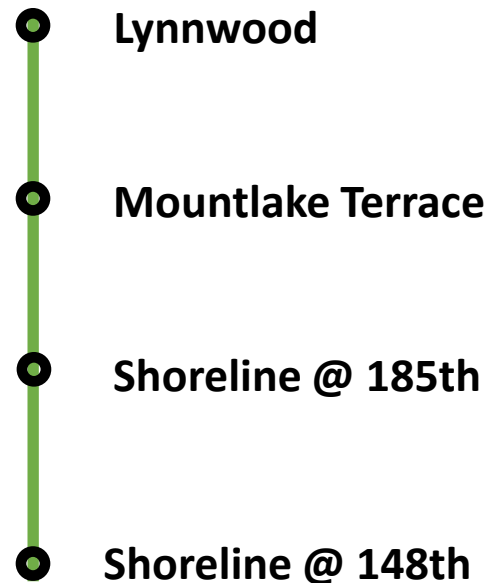


Link Extensions – Recent & Pending

- 2021 U-District, Roosevelt, Northgate
- 2024 April: East Link Extension
- 2024 August: Lynnwood Extension
- 2025 TBD: East Link connection to Seattle
- 2026: Federal Way Extension

Metro Last Mile Connections to the Hospital

- Significant transit improvements
- Route 65 and 75 long standing
- Route 31/32 across NE 45th improved connections and frequency of service
