# Steps to a more efficient organic garden utilizing seasonal plant waste:

- ▶ 1. Cut up your green/brown plant waste.
- 2. Find an empty space in your garden at least 10 inches wide.
- > 3. Dig a trench at least 8-10 inches deep.
- ▶ 4. Add the plant waste to your trench.
- 5. Cover the trench with soil.
- 6. Voila! You are done! You can plant over this area and the plant waste will nourish your new plants.

# Cut up your green/brown plant waste into small pieces.



# Find an empty space —this area used to house a potato plant that was harvested.



### Dig a trench at least 8+ inches deep and 8-10 inches wide.



# Add cut green/brown waste to the trench.



# Cover green waste in trench completely with dirt.



#### Voila! You're DONE!!!! You can plant in this area with soil that will nourish your plants.
