### How can this support my work?

This program will match you up with a local architecture firm with child care facility design experience. The firm will provide pre-development services that include:

- Assessing the feasibility of new facility expansion opportunities
- Develop design options that fit your needs
- Develop initial drawings and cost estimates to get your project ready for construction
- Provide expert advice and partnership in the planning stages of any construction work you are considering

### How do I apply and receive services?

Once the scope has been agreed upon by all parties the work can commence. DEEL will cover the costs of the services.
