## Partial Certification Memo

OIG has reviewed the investigation for case number 2021OPA-0522. OIG can certify this case as thorough and objective. However, this investigation cannot be certified as timely.

Under section 3.29.260 (B) of Seattle's Accountability Ordinance, initial investigations shall be submitted, "to OIG for OIG's review sufficiently in advance of investigation deadlines in order to allow the deadlines to be met in the event OIG directs additional investigation."

In this case, 2021OPA-0522 was submitted to OIG for initial review on Thursday, June 9, 2022, just nine days before the expiration of the 180- day investigation period on June 17, 2022. Accordingly, this investigation cannot be certified as timely.
