On <u>February 16, 2023</u>, OPA routed this case to OIG with a request to review post-Loudermill information which was obtained and provided in response to requests made by Seattle Police Department's Chief Diaz.

OIG appreciates the discussions had with OPA regarding the distinct concern raised by Chief Diaz, the additional investigative steps he requested, and the unique response it garnered in OPA providing clarification of the neuroscience around human factors and cognitive distraction through expert guidance. OIG also acknowledges the particularity of this case, as well as the fact that it is not precedent setting.
