## **Partial Certification Memo**

OIG has reviewed the investigation for case number <u>2022OPA-0336 and</u> appreciates OPA's additional effort in conducting second interviews with the named employees. This case can now be certified as both <u>timely</u> and <u>objective</u>.

As previously mentioned in OIG's February 27, 2023, Request for Additional Investigation Memo, this case cannot be certified as <u>thorough</u> because the named employees' displayed effort and care that were simply too lacking to exclude SPD's professionalism policy from the review of potential policy violations.

Accordingly, OIG can certify this case as both <u>timely</u> and <u>objective</u>, but it cannot be certified as <u>thorough</u>.
