Partial Certification Memo

OIG has reviewed the investigation for case 2025OPA-0068.

Under Article 3.6 (A) of the SPOG CBA, “the OPA shall furnish the [named] employee and the Guild with a classification report no later than thirty (30) days after receipt of the complaint by the OPA.”

In this case, OPA received the complaint on November 21, 2024. The 30-day notice was sent on April 1, 2025. This untimeliness, which according to SPOG, is taken into consideration in cases where discipline is being considered, cannot be certified by OIG.

Accordingly, OIG can certify this case as objective and thorough but not timely.
