## **OIG EXP INV Certification Memo**

OIG has reviewed the expedited investigation request for case 2025OPA-0134. The investigation is certified as thorough, timely, and objective.

While reviewing this case, OIG noticed OPA did not obtain explicit consent to record the Complainant interview on the recording, however the beginning of the interview clearly indicates the recording was discussed by both parties prior to the start of the recorded interview. As a result, OIG maintains the case is thorough, timely, and objective, but asks OPA to ensure permission to record is captured on the audio file and not just discussed prior to the start of the recorded interview.
