# Topic

• Miranda Warnings

## Summary

• It was alleged that officers did not read Miranda warnings when arresting a protester.

# Analysis

- <u>SPD Policy 6.010-POL-3</u> requires that arrestees be read their Miranda warnings "as soon as practical" after being taken into custody.
- The complainant was not subjected to questioning during the custodial arrest and, as such, the failure to read Miranda warnings was a technical violation.
- The failure to provide the Miranda advisement was likely the result of the chaotic nature of the demonstration and the lack of clear roles and responsibilities between arresting officers and officers who processed the arrest.

## **Recommendation**(s)

• Ensure that officer roles are clear in protest arrests so that Miranda warnings are read when required.
