1	WHEREAS, in 2021, after completing a public engagement process, OPCD presented a final
2	Crown Hill Action Plan to the City Council Land Use and Neighborhoods Committee on
3	December 3, 2021; and
4	WHEREAS, the Crown Hill Urban Village Action Plan recommends numerous implementation
5	measures including creation of neighborhood design guidelines to help realize the
6	community's vision by shaping new development in the neighborhood; and
7	WHEREAS, in a statement of legislative intent for the 2022 budget, the City Council asked
8	OPCD and the Seattle Department of Construction and Inspections (SDCI) to convene a
9	stakeholder group to conduct a Racial Equity Toolkit (RET) review of the design review
10	program, and the RET process is currently underway and could result in
11	recommendations for improvements to design review that would further racially equitable
12	outcomes; and
13	WHEREAS, OPCD conducted another online survey specifically on neighborhood design
14	guidelines and conducted in-person engagement at the Crown Hill street fair in June
15	2022, and input from the survey and in-person engagement is incorporated into the
16	proposed neighborhood design guidelines; NOW, THEREFORE,
17	BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:
