Introducing new Board member recommendations and update on the appointment process

- Notice of Appointments have been sent to the appointing authorities
- Expected to present to the City Council Sustainability, City Light, and Arts and Culture subcommittee on July 11th
- Currently working with the Mayor's office to fill the remaining labor seat and undergoing
 Tribal engagement to fill the vacant Tribal Representative seat
- Jazzmin Fragiacomo shared information about the onboarding process for incoming GND
 Oversight Board members, including the timeline and activities that staff are suggesting for
 onboarding.
 - o Board members who are terming off are invited to continue to participate on the Board until new Board members are officially sworn in.
 - Andrea Ornelas shared that she really likes the idea of a Board Buddy. She also shared that she has notes for the Knowledge Transfer document that she would like to share.
 - Steve Gelb brought up the issue of Board attendance and wanting to make sure that we
 are doing what we can to maximize meeting attendance and participation. He also brought
 up the point of capacity, and not doing too many onboarding activities.

Presentation: Clean Heat Letter of Support by Saurabh Harohalli and Christine Bunch

- **Saurabh Harohalli,** OSE's Clean Heat Coordinator, introduced himself and **Christine Bunch** and OSE's Government Affairs and Climate and Energy Advisor
 - Puget Sound Energy's (PSE) decarbonization grant is funded by the Climate Commitment Act
 (CCA) and offers \$3 Million to help convert any natural gas customers to electric appliances.
 - OSE is trying to expand their Clean Heat program and is seeking letters of support to submit with the grant application.
 - OSE is asking for \$1 million, which would serve 140 low to moderate income households.
 - Some funds will be reserved for admin and community engagement.
