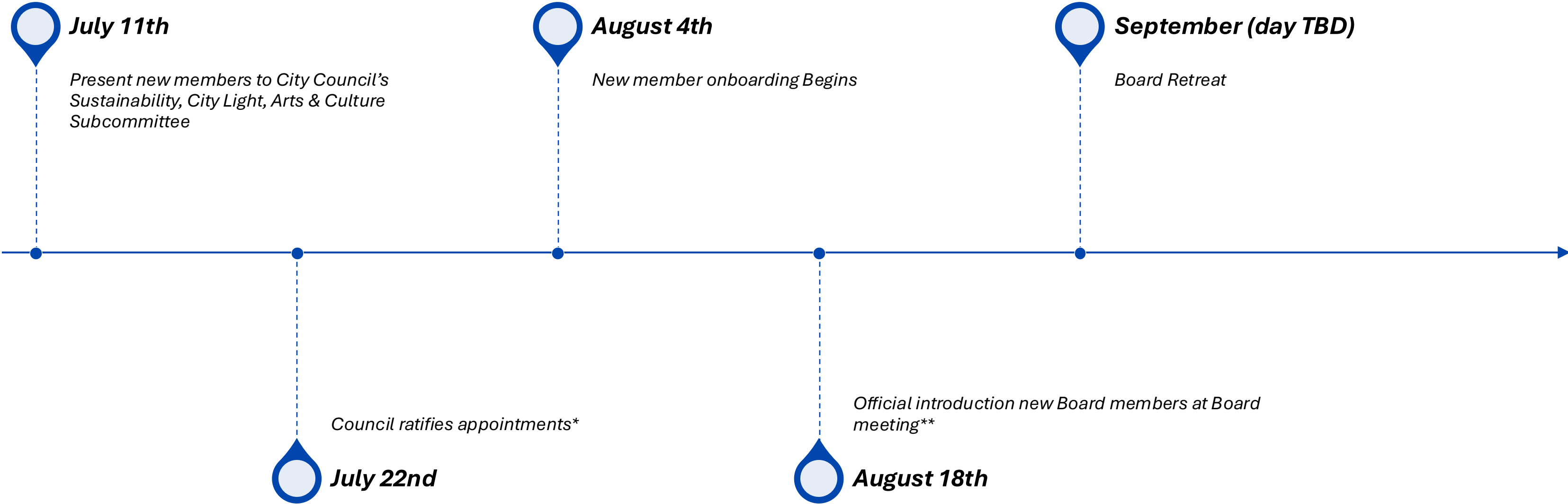

Onboarding Tasks

- **Board Retreat** - For whole Board but we see it as an Onboarding opportunity.
- **Developing “Knowledge Transfer” document** – This document will function as a way to maintain institutional knowledge from the members of the PPP Subcommittee.
 - Will contain process and how to's on PPP projects like Budget Recommendations
 - Will need Broad review on this document
- **New member 1:1s with Staff and Executive Committee** – Initial meeting to orient new Board members to current Board activities
- **Two-part Onboarding Series** – Two likely virtual (maybe in person) onboarding meetings
 - Go over Onboarding Packet
 - Understand new member's hopes, goals, and concerns for their time on the Board
 - Presentation on GND, the Board's structure, current work, etc.
- **Board Buddy** – Pair current board members with new members to help foster a sense of community as well as allow the new members an opportunity to learn from their peers.
 - Buddies to set up 1:1 initial meeting then meet on a regular basis that makes sense for both parties
 - Will need Board support
- **Monthly Onboarding “book club”** – A monthly hour long “book club” style onboarding meeting where new members can ask questions, check in, meet current and former members.
 - **Goal:** To provide a low commitment and accessible onboarding resource of incoming members
