

# Clean Cities Initiative (CCI) Weekly Report

March 25, 2021

Reporting Week March 15 through March 21

## **Week in Review**

This week community clean team focused on two large emphasis areas in addition to the various litter and trash pick-up locations citywide. The two emphasis areas included: Kinnear Park and North Acres Park. 58 additional Clean Cities sites were also completed. The following summary includes Clean Cities work accomplished by Parks/SDOT Clean Cities Crews.

#### By the Numbers:

- 1,450 needles collected
- 1,400 lbs. of debris removed during the jamboree clean at Kinnear Park and North Acres Park.
- 60,806.5 lbs. trash collected via Community Clean Teams
- 73 blocks of litter pickup by SDOT crew
- 497 tents counted onsite; 4 abandoned tents removed








## **Clean Cities Emphasis Areas**

• Kinnear Park – 3/16, The Encampment Team removed 1100 lbs. debris and 21 needles from the park. SDOT crew repaired washed out service road by replenishing with gravel in several sections. The washout was caused by heavy rains. The Seattle Conservation Corps worked on making improvements to the DOLA by removing urine filled wood chips and relacing with gravel. CW crew cut back overgrown foliage and invasive weeds along a terraced wall. A staff member trimmed by blackberry on a stairway making it safe for pedestrians.
