

Clean Cities Community Clean Teams Weekly Report

May 27, 2021

Reporting Week May 17 through May 23

Week in Review

This week the community clean team focused on two large emphasis areas including Homer Harris Park and Mapes Creek at Beer Sheva Park, besides the various litter and trash pick-up locations citywide. 31 additional Clean Cities sites were completed by the Parks/SDOT Clean Cities Teams and 14 additional sites were completed by SDOT crews alone. The following summary includes Clean Cities work accomplished by Parks/SDOT Clean Cities Crews.

By the Numbers:

- 653 needles collected
- 350 lbs. of debris removed during the jamboree clean at Homer Harris Park
- 139,380 lbs. trash collected via Community Clean Teams
- 14 blocks of litter pickup by SDOT crews
- 2 miles of vegetation management by SDOT crew
- 295 tents counted onsite
- 7 structures of graffiti cleaned

Clean Cities Emphasis Areas

Homer Harris Park -5/18. 2-Tents, 5-Structures, 350lbs of debris. CE District hedge trimmed overgrown vegetation protruding into the pathway of vehicles in an alley from parks property. The interior of the park was line trimmed in preparation for mowing and hedge trimming along the fence line was addressed. Weeds were removed from the play area. The informational slats were repositioned in the rainbow sign.

Mapes Creek at Beer Sheva Park-5/20. This project is a continuation from work performed from a previous jamboree. The work began at the bridge with the crew removing litter and garbage from the creek bed. Crews removed blackberry and other invasive vegetation. Thinning of overgrown vegetation of Asters, Lupines, Spirea and limping of Willow and Ash trees. The crew line trimmed the entire fence line inside and out. A maintenance mower operator mowed the park.

The Crews will be doing litter picks, trash mitigation; any Bio- Hazard removal that may be required, and related grounds maintenance work.
