

Clean Cities Community Clean Teams Weekly Report

July 1, 2021

Reporting Week June 21 through June 27

Week in Review

This week the community clean team focused on two large emphasis areas including Duwamish Head Greenspace and Greenwood Park, as well as the various litter and trash pick-up locations citywide. There were 33 additional Clean Cities sites were completed by the Parks Clean Cities Teams and 15 additional sites were completed by SDOT crews. The following summary includes Clean Cities work accomplished by Parks/SDOT Clean Cities Crews.

By the Numbers:

- 1,791 needles collected
- 76,520 lbs. trash collected via Community Clean Teams
- 25 blocks of litter pickup by SDOT crews
- 276 tents counted onsite
- 14.15 miles of vegetation management
- 53 signs of graffiti cleaned





Clean Cities Emphasis Areas

• Duwamish Head Greenspace: 6/23. SW District hosted their jamboree at the Duwamish Head Greenspace with 7 districts supported the work. The jamboree consisted of line trimming vegetation back from slope along the sidewalk. Several crew members scraped the sidewalk clean of mud and soil which had run off from slope. They dug out drainage paths for water to drain off sidewalk into the gutter and storm drain. Litter and shopping carts were removed from the site. There is a prominent social trail that leads from the eco blocks up to an encampment.




Greenwood Park: 6/24. NW District hosed their jamboree at Greenwood Park with 7 other districts sending
a staff person for support. The work consisted of line trimming the bioswale area along Evanston Ave N.,
edging the walkways, tree rings were line trimmed for mulching. Some crew weeded a large shrub bed in
preparation for a small group of volunteers to mulch.

The Crews will be doing litter picks, trash mitigation; any Bio- Hazard removal that may be required, and related grounds maintenance work. Crews will also be providing maintenance and cleaning efforts both in and around these parks. Field inspections and cleaning of right of way areas will include stairways, multi-use paths, streets, and sidewalks in the immediate vicinity of these parks.
