

Clean Cities Community Clean Teams Weekly Report

August 26, 2021

Reporting Week August 16 through August 22

Week in Review

This week the community clean team focused on two large emphasis areas, Prichard Beach Park and Kinnear Park as well as the various litter and trash pick-up locations citywide. There was a jamboree and volunteer project on the same day at Kinnear Park. The following summary includes Clean Cities work accomplished by Parks/SDOT Clean Cities Crews and volunteers.

By the Numbers:

- Trash mitigation completed at 30 locations by Parks crews, 20 locations by SDOT crews
- 2090 needles collected by Parks Crews
- 93,570 lbs. trash collected via Community Clean Teams
- 21 blocks of litter pickup by SDOT crews
- 3.2 miles of vegetation management
- 283 tents counted onsite
- 7 signs of graffiti removed

Clean Cities Emphasis Areas

• Prichard Beach Park: 8/17. SE District line trimmed an overgrown hillside of weeds and tall grasses. The hillside extended to the back of the bathhouse facility. Several trees with low hanging branches were trimmed up. Cracks in the sidewalk and parking lot have been line trimmed as well. Staff blew the parking lot after the line trimming was completed.

• Kinnear Park: 8/19. CW District's Clean City Project addressed deferred maintenance removing blackberries, weeding shrub beds and mulching (in top and lower tier of shrub beds). Work performed on the North and South side of tennis court and along fence line cutting and removing blackberries and graffiti. Tractor was used to help spread mulch in the lower tier, and lastly blew pathway and stairs.

• Kinnear Park Volunteer Project: 8/19. Number of Volunteers: 4. Activities Performed by Volunteers: Cutting out blackberry, other weeds and mulching bed after weeds removed. CW-Senior Gardner Jody Blecksmith brought tools and other supplies to the project for volunteers to use. 3 volunteers arrived on-site and 1-returning volunteer. Once volunteers arrived, we did a quick safety briefing and thanked them for coming out. There were some weeds and plants identified by Senior Gardner to have the volunteers remove using hand-tools. Lastly, volunteers assisted in spreading mulch in lower tier of the shrub beds.
