

Clean Cities Community Clean Teams Weekly Report

September 1, 2021

Reporting Week August 23 through August 27

Week in Review

This week the community clean team focused on one large emphasis areas Kinnear Park, as well as the various litter and trash pick-up locations citywide. We had two Jamboree's and one Volunteer project this week (NW-District/Golden Gardens and SW-District/Lincoln Park). The following summary includes Clean Cities work accomplished by Parks/SDOT Clean Cities Crews.

By the Numbers:

- Trash mitigation completed at 38 locations by Parks crews
- Trash mitigation completed at 15 locations by SDOT crews
- 650 needles collected by Parks Crews
- 34,570 lbs. trash collected via Community Clean Teams
- 7 blocks of litter pickup by SDOT crews
- 10.5 miles of vegetation management
- 360 tents counted onsite
- 7 signs of graffiti removed

Clean Cities Emphasis Areas

Kinnear Park: 8/23 CW District addressed deferred maintenance removing blackberries, weeding shrub beds and mulching (in top and lower tier of shrub beds). Work performed on the North and South side of tennis court and along fence line cutting and removing blackberries. Tractor was used to help spread mulch in the lower tier, and lastly blew pathway and stairs.
