Magnuson Community Center Report

MPAC members express general appreciation for MESA and the ongoing hard work its members continue to perform.

King asks for details about the Hangar2 development group; Orsucci provides details.

Old & New Business

MPAC members share issues concerning their constituent/advocacy groups.

- Hudacek notes ongoing concerns about traffic safety and parking, particularly along 63rd Ave NE
- Mejia-Giudici raises concerns regarding safety and security within the Naval Air Station Historic District

Hudacek also notes that the Magnuson Park online calendar does not always accurately reflect Park events. Orsucci responds that she agrees and is working with the work units that issue the calendar to improve it and provide a better and more accurate calendar.
