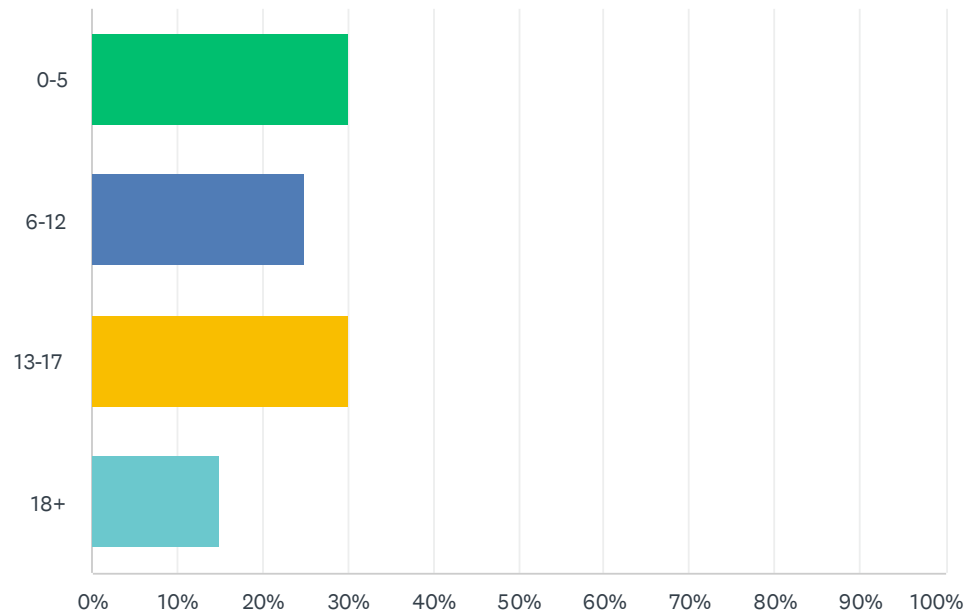


## Q1 How old are you or your child?

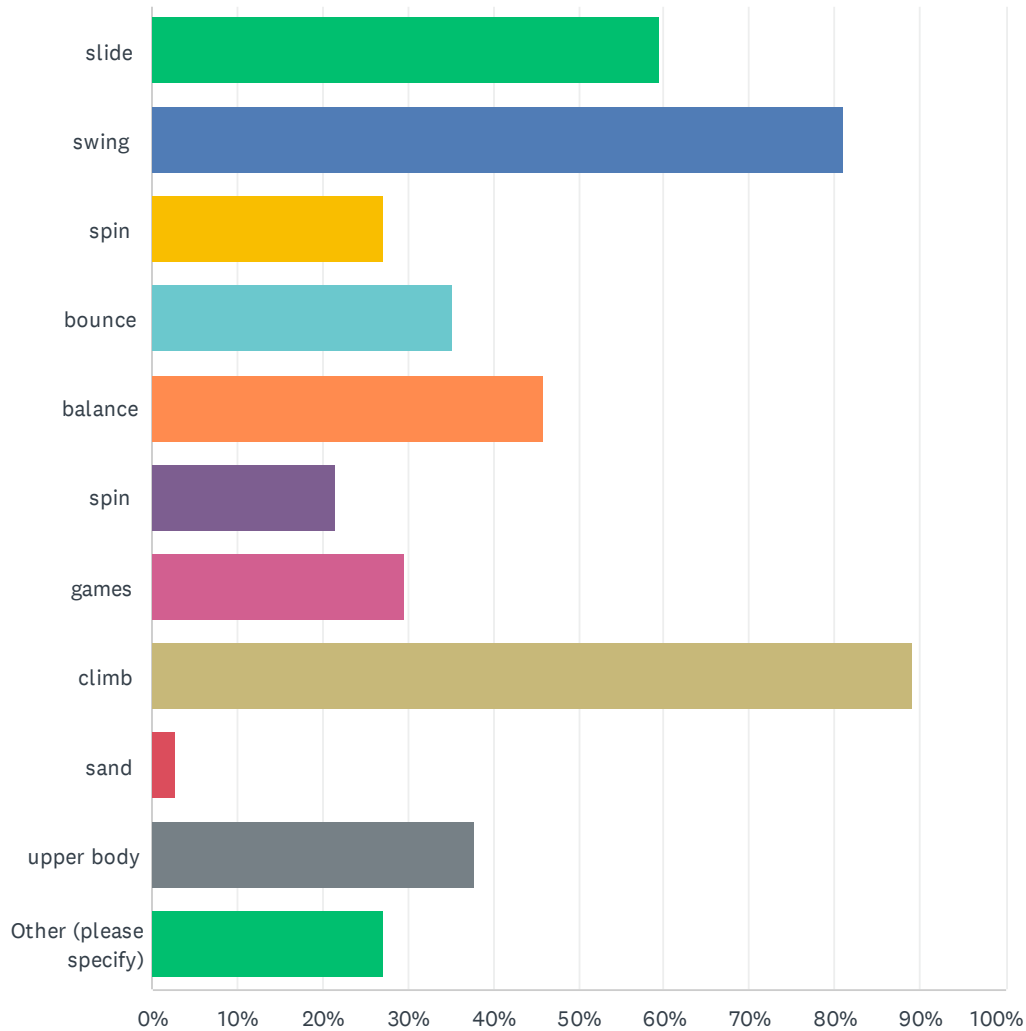

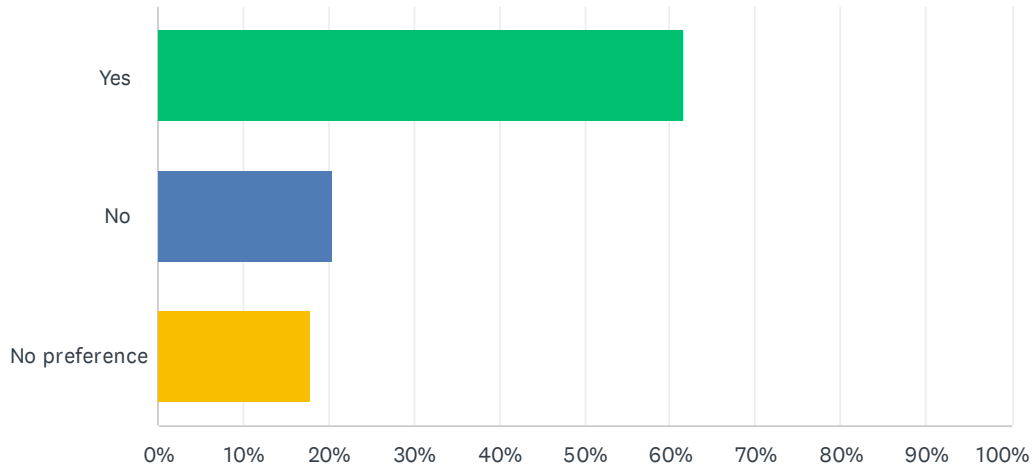
