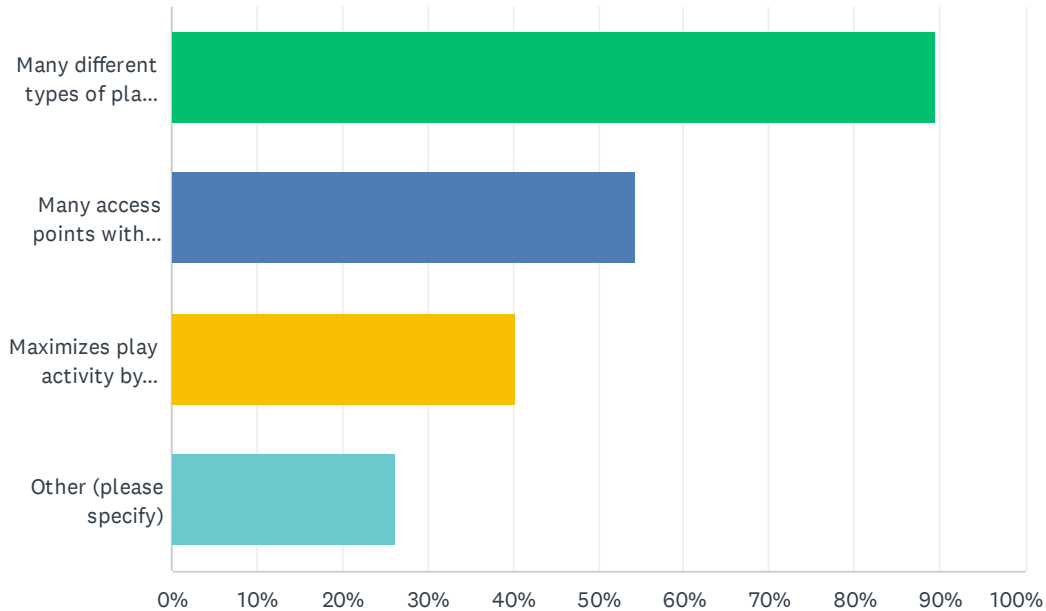


# Q1 What do you like about the existing play equipment? Check all that apply

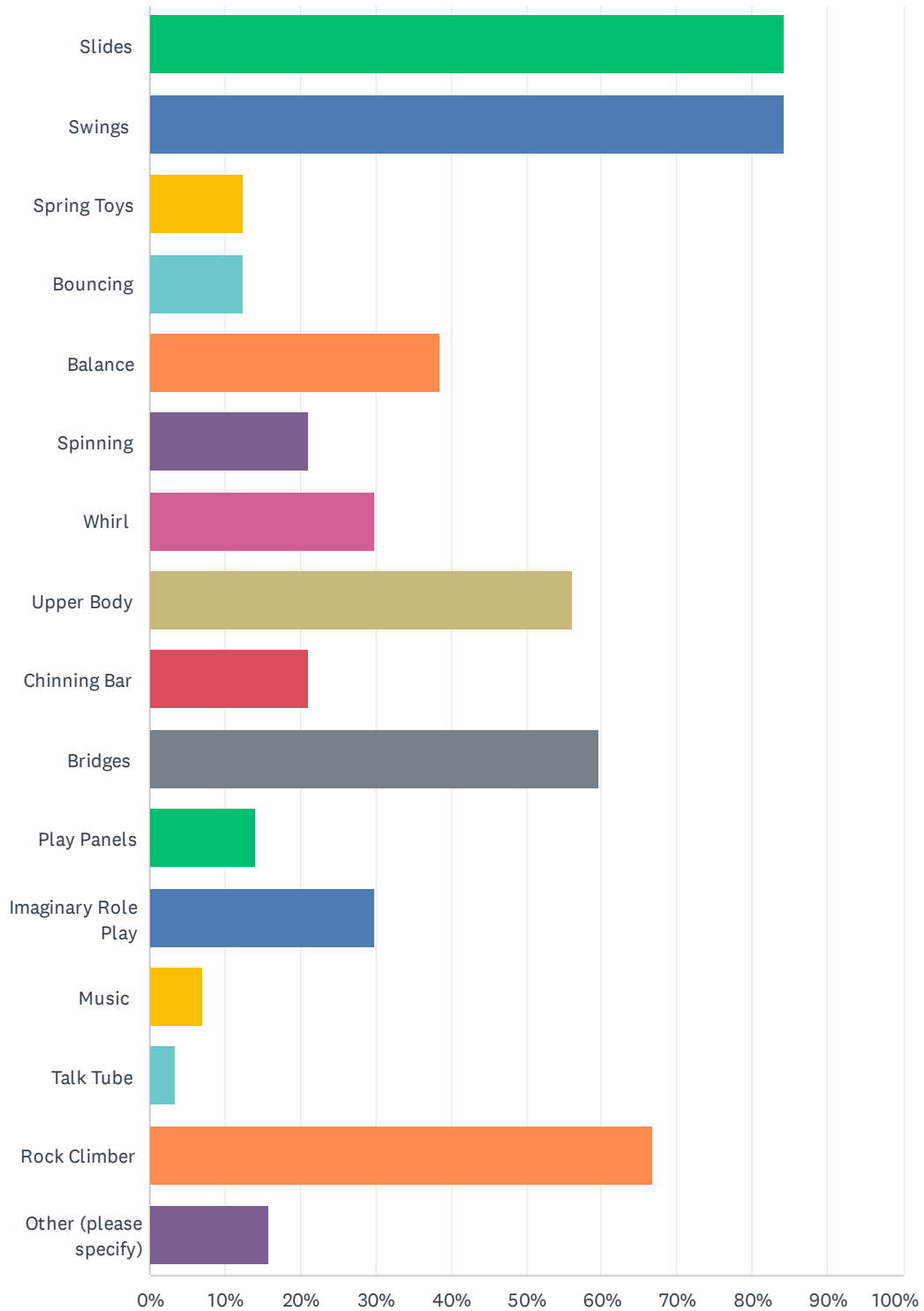

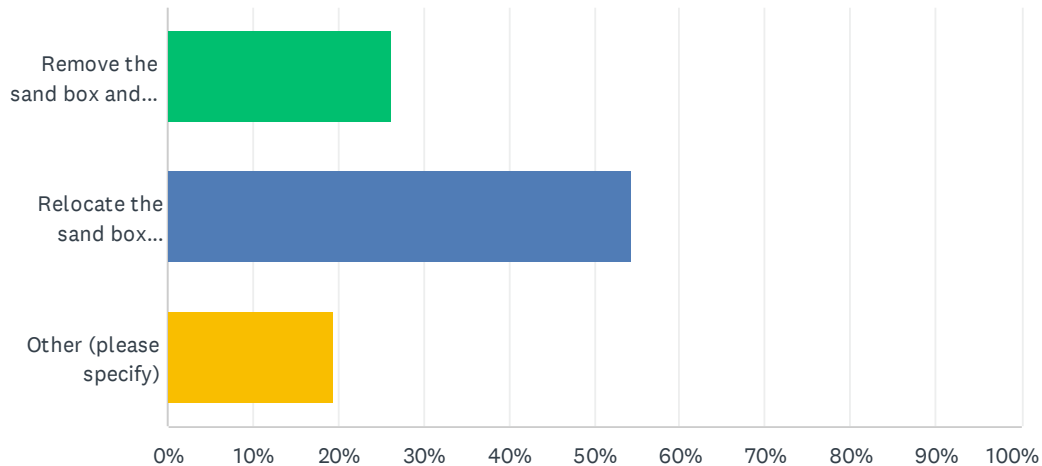

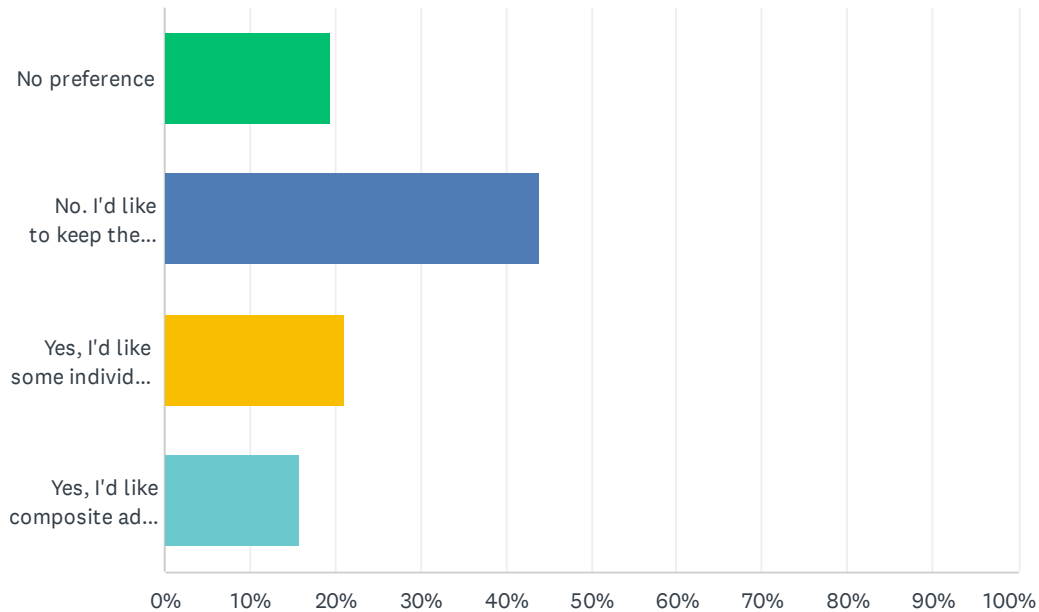
