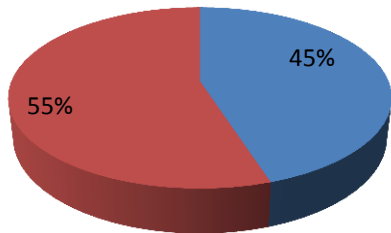

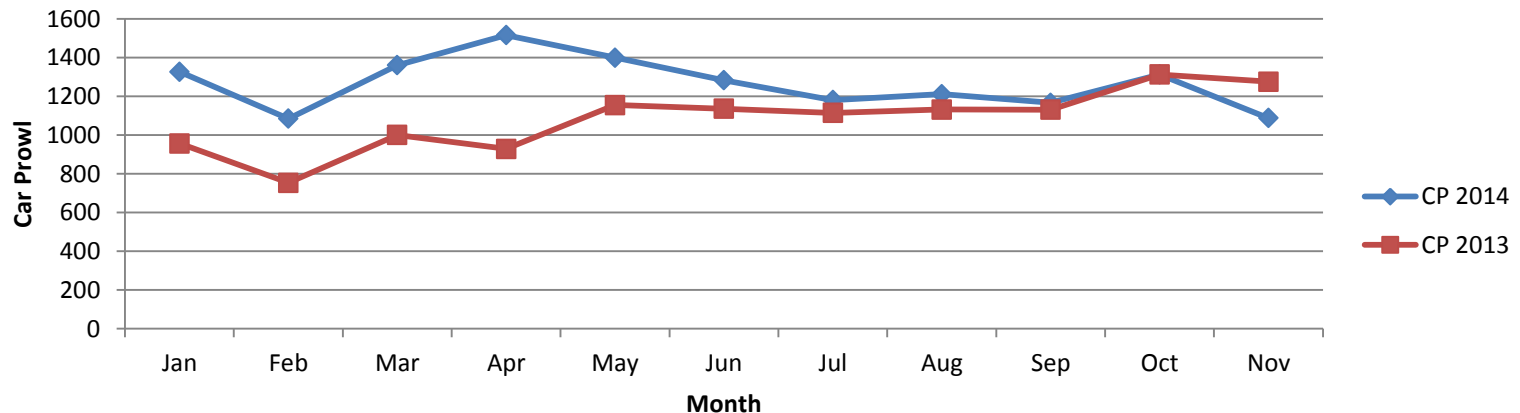
Car Prowl Percentage within Larceny-Theft

■ Other Theft (Includes Shoplifting) ■ Car Prowl

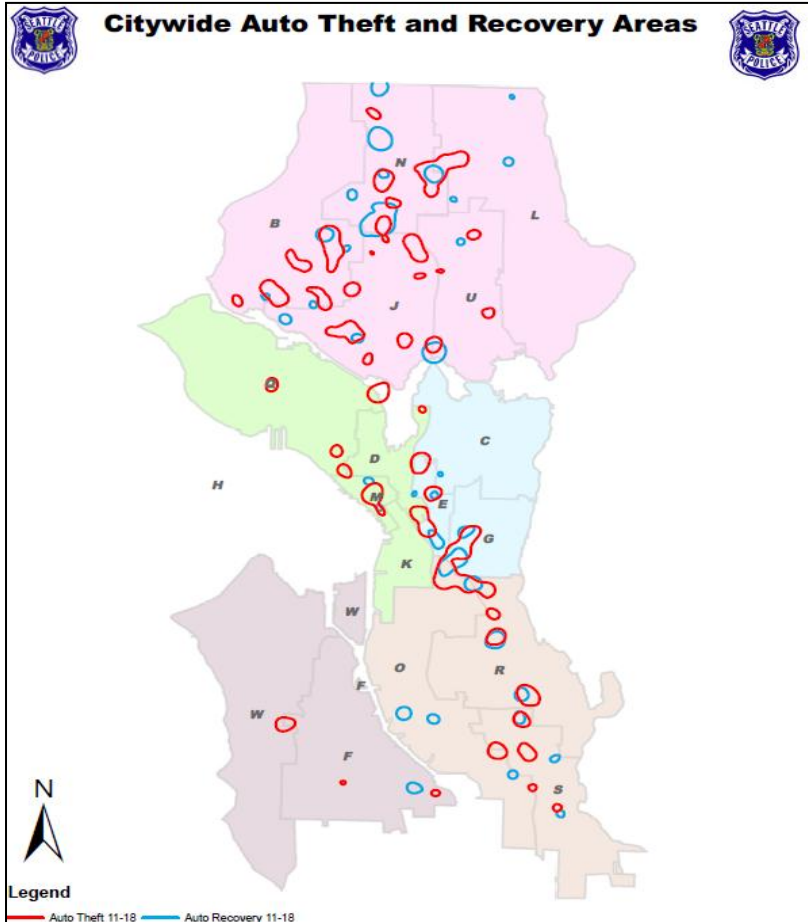


63% of the major crime category can be attributed to Larceny-Theft. Car Prowl accounts for 35% of the overall major crime category.

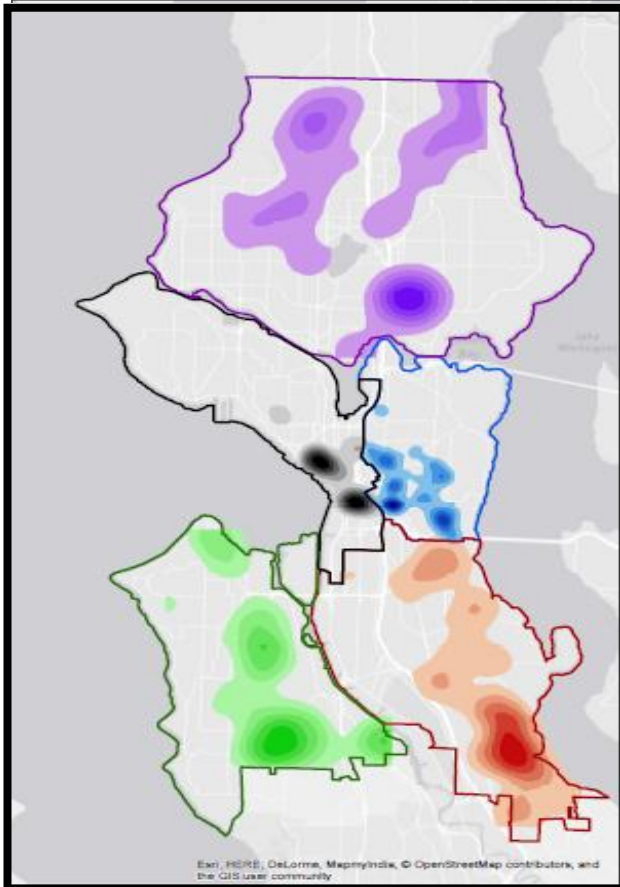

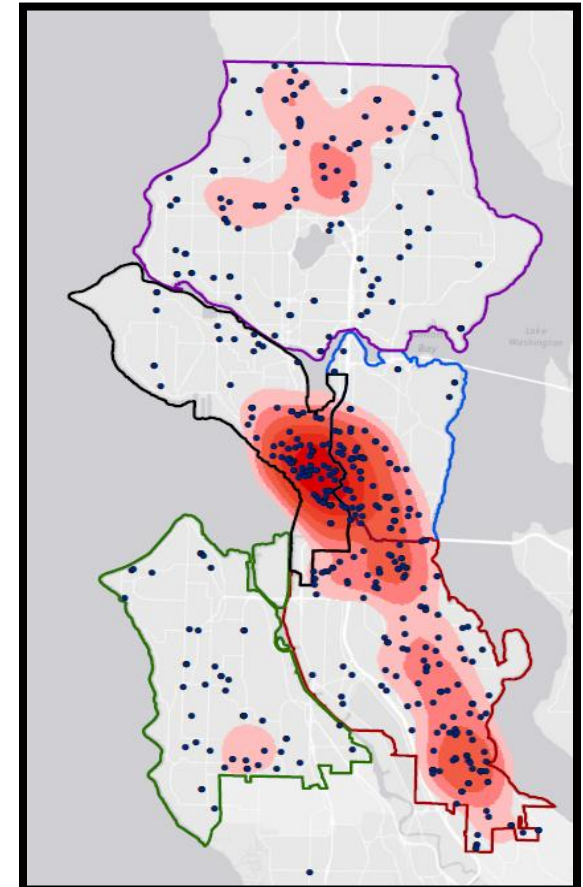

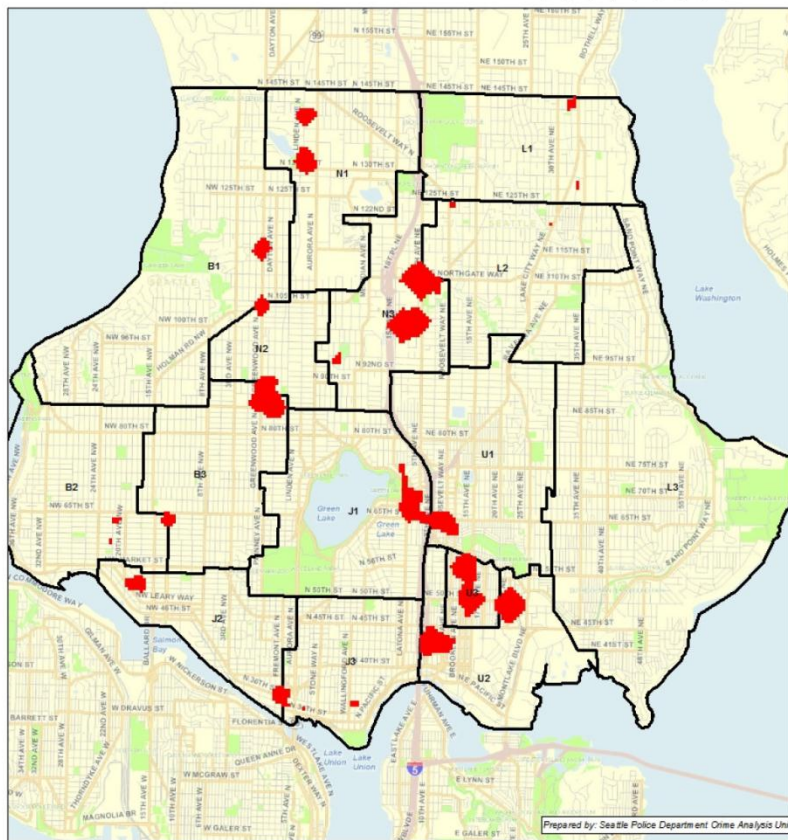
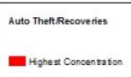
North Precinct Auto Theft

Auto Theft/Recoveries

Map identifies the areas in the North Precinct where auto theft and vehicle recoveries are concentrated.

Identified areas account for 19% of all vehicles stolen and 8% of all recovered vehicles.

Recovery Rate:

77 % of vehicles stolen in the North Precinct are recovered. The average time to vehicle recovery is 7 days.

At Risk Vehicles: 83% of all stolen vehicles in the North Precinct are model year 2001 and older.

The vehicles most likely to be stolen are:

TIME OF DAY: Precinct wide Auto Thefts are typically stolen between 2100 and 0100 hrs.

DAY OF WEEK: Monday, Thursday and Tuesday are the most active.

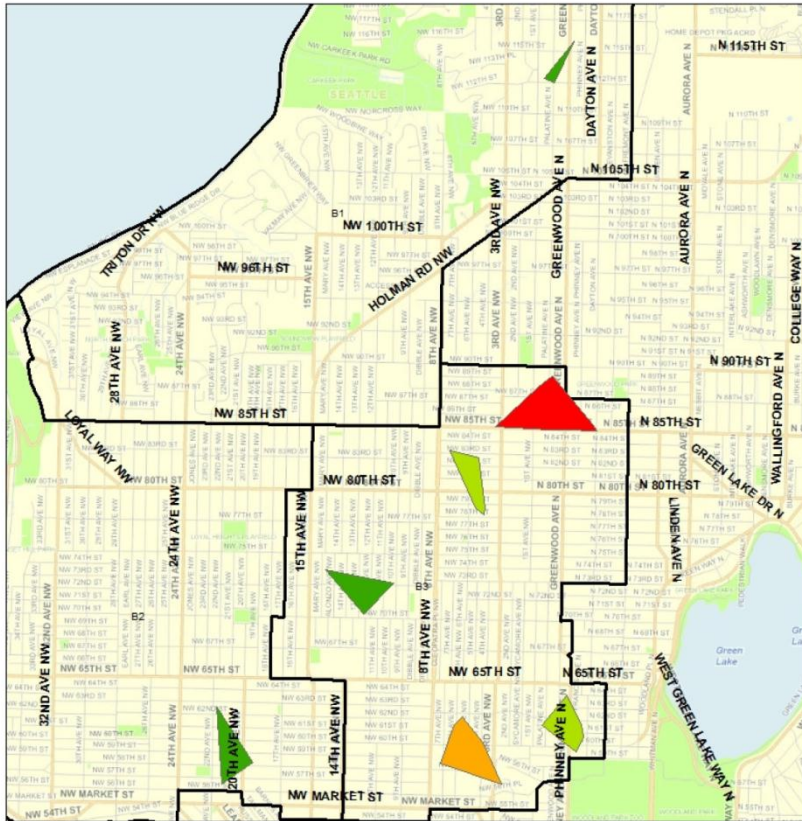
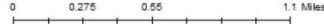
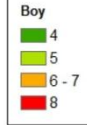
North Precinct Auto Theft

Number of Incidents: 8 robberies covering 7 reports

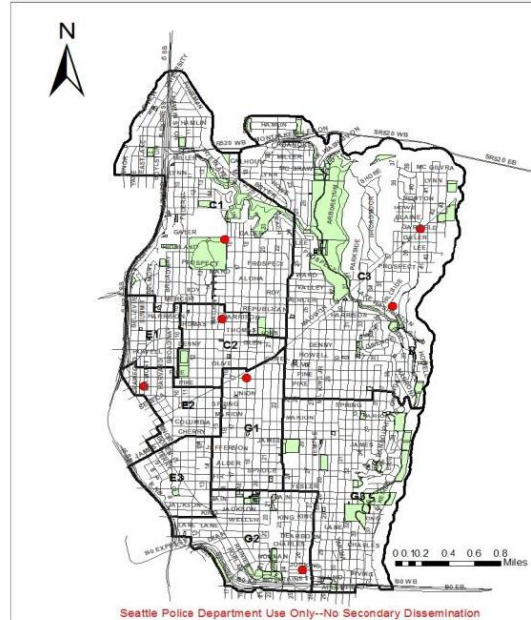
Date Range: 11/21/14-11/29/14

Most Common Property Stolen: wallets and phones

Caution: All reports include the display of a handgun. In 3 reports victims were pistol whipped.
