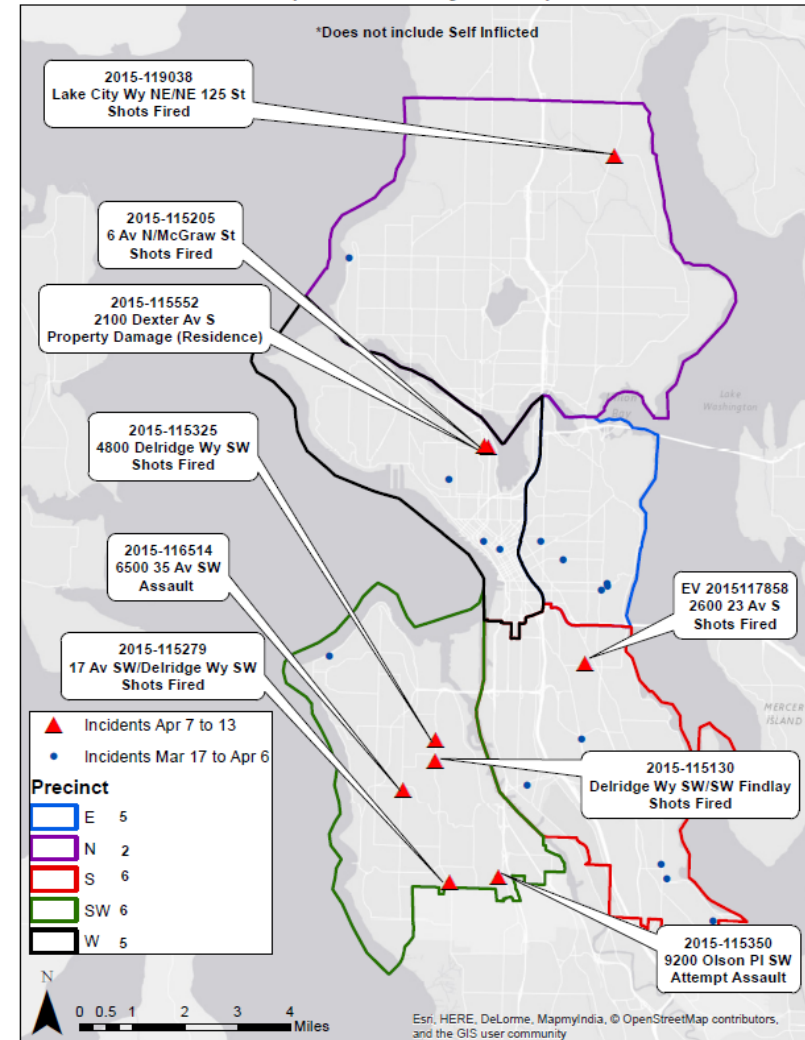

▪ Deaths: 2 suicides, 3 OIS, and 4 homicides

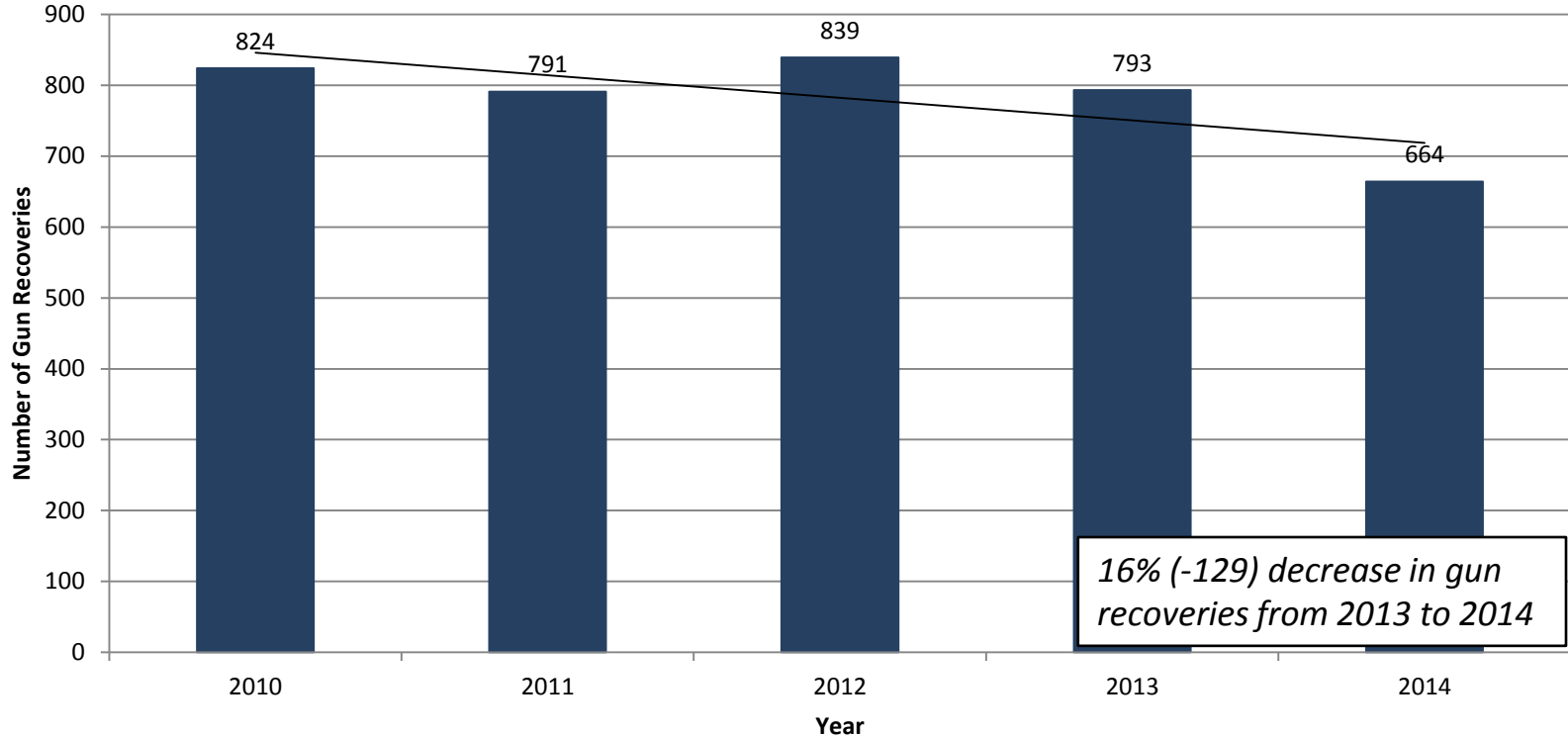
2015 YTD – 25 GOs with Injuries (17) or Death (8)

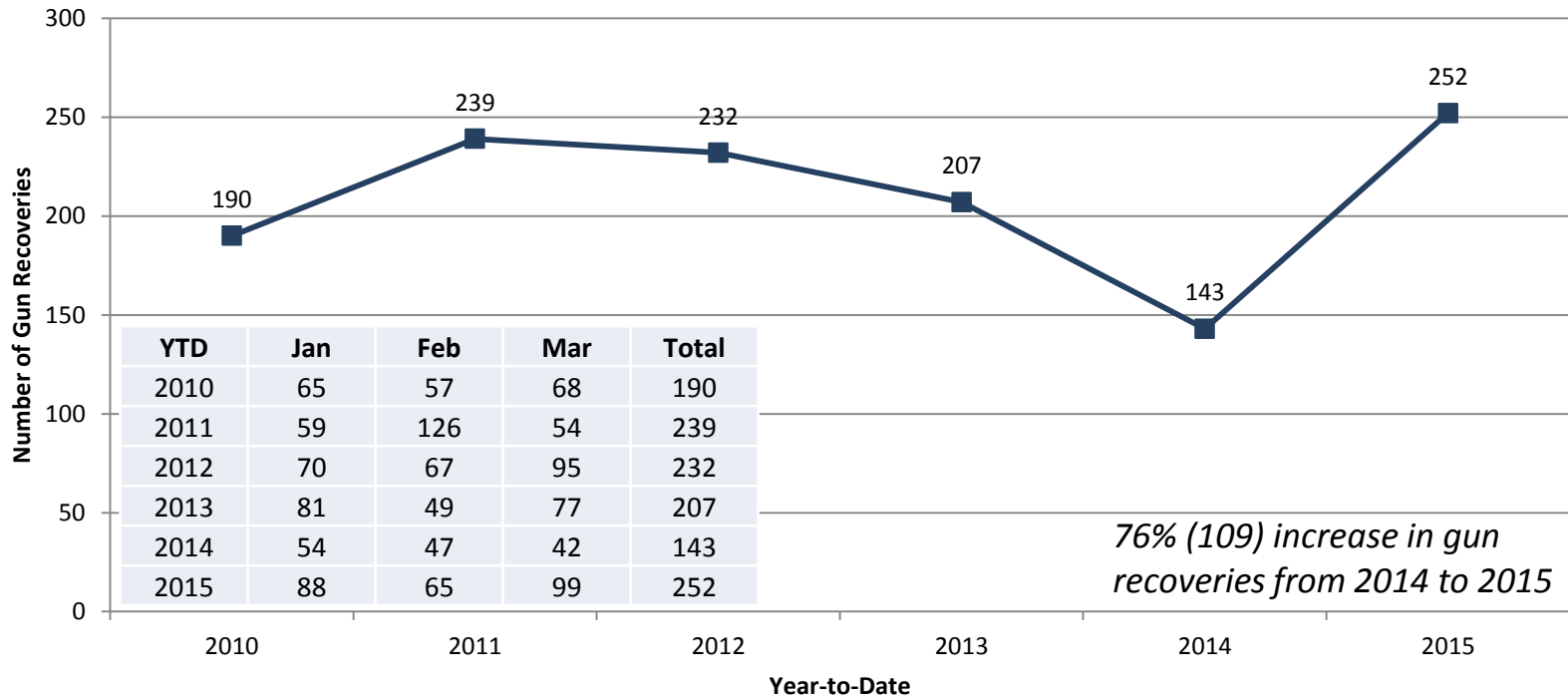
## Annual Gun Recovery Totals: 2010-2014

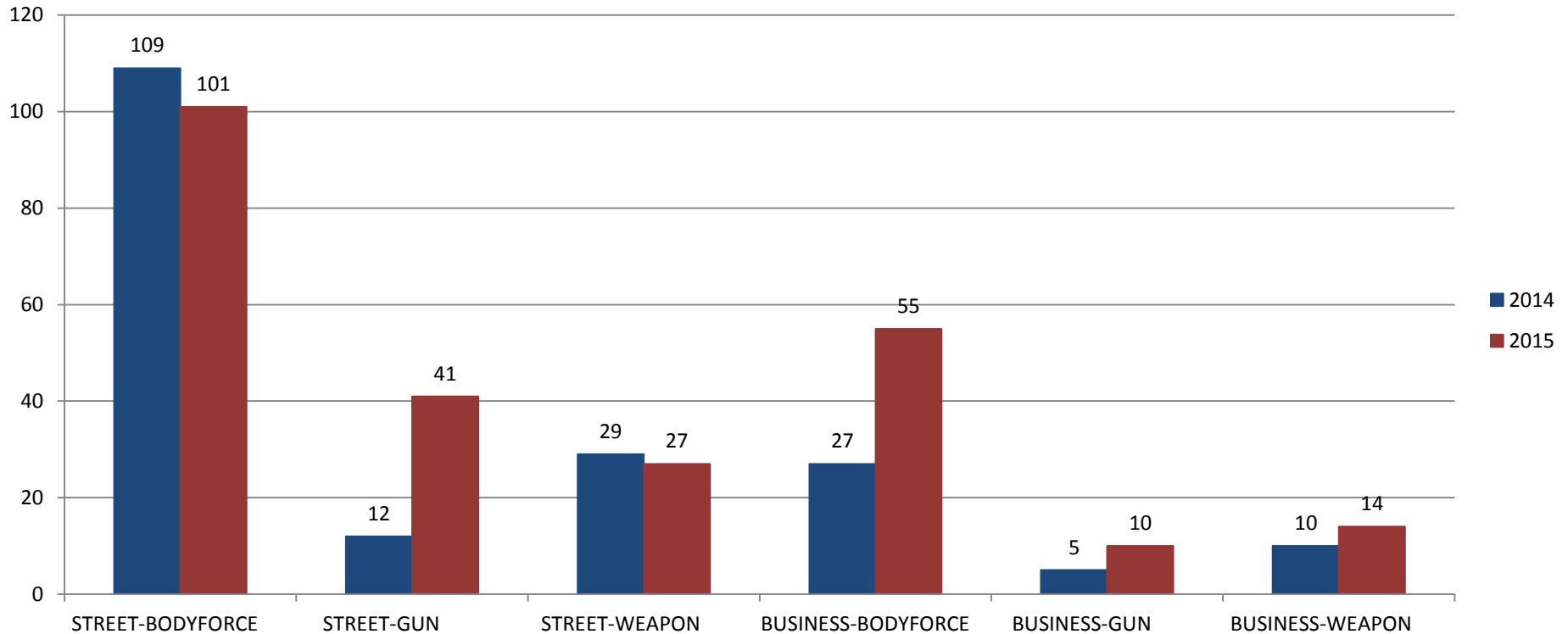

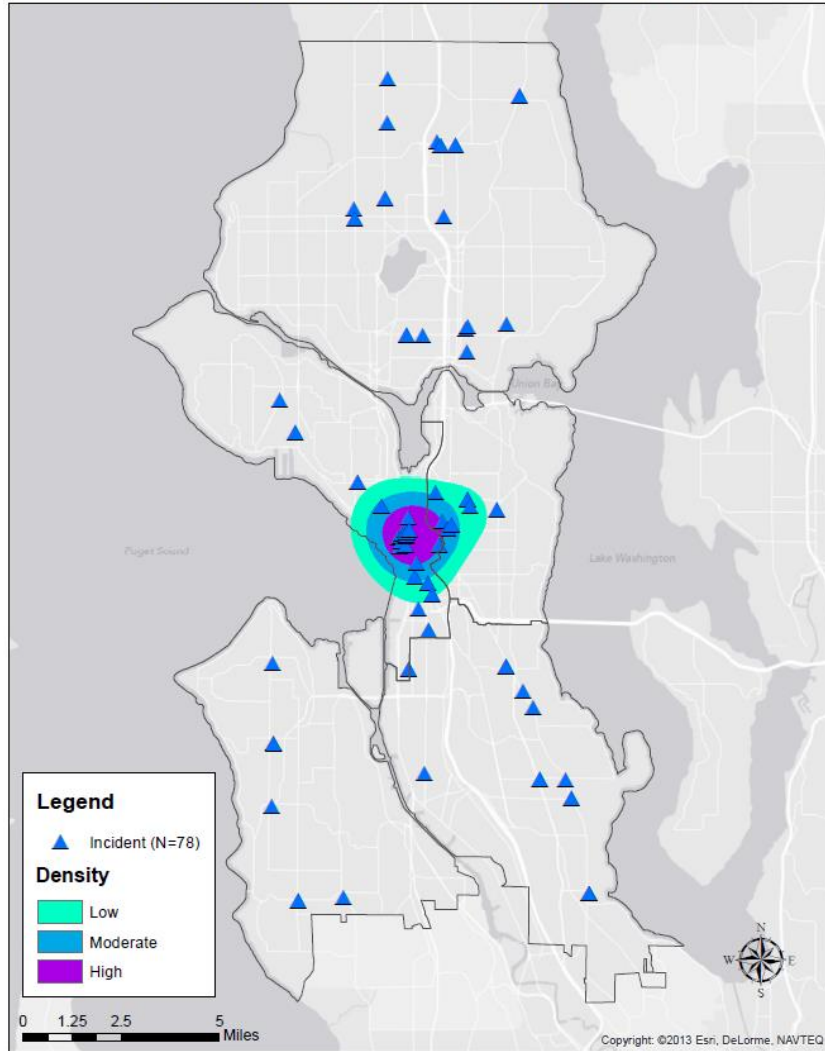

## Robbery - Street and Business by Weapon Type January 1 to February 28 (2014 and 2015)

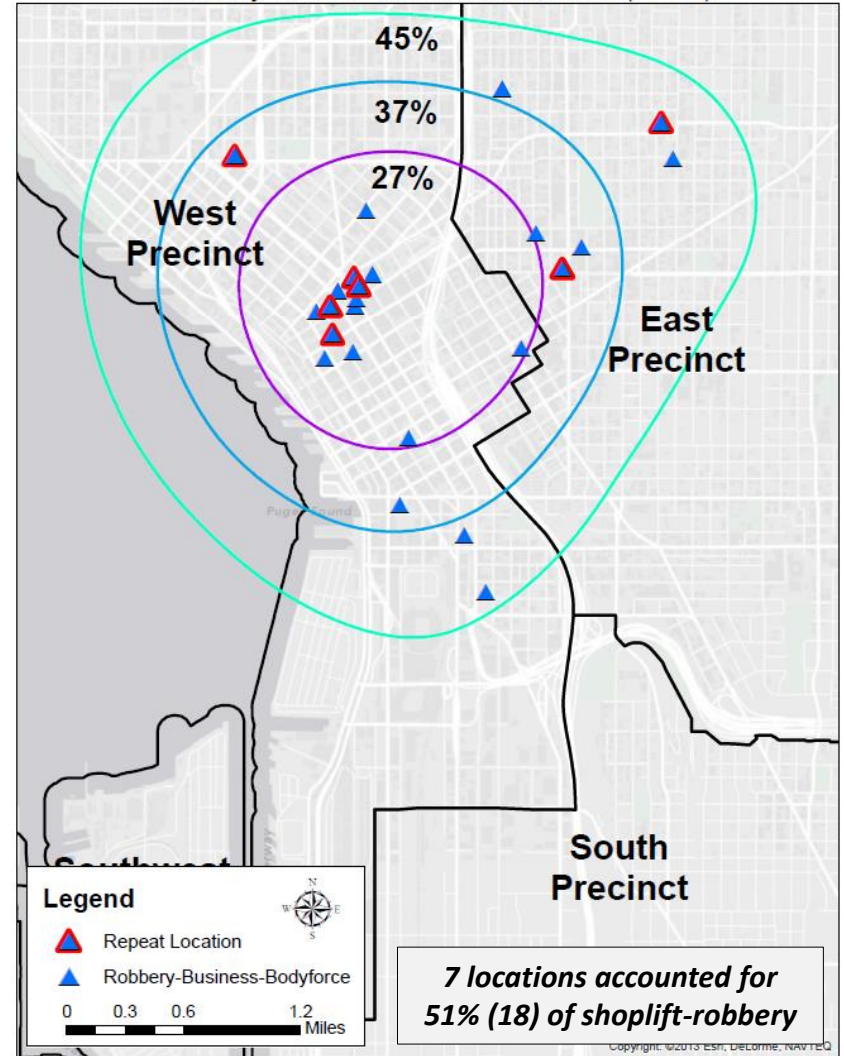




Citywide Robbery-Business-Bodyforce
