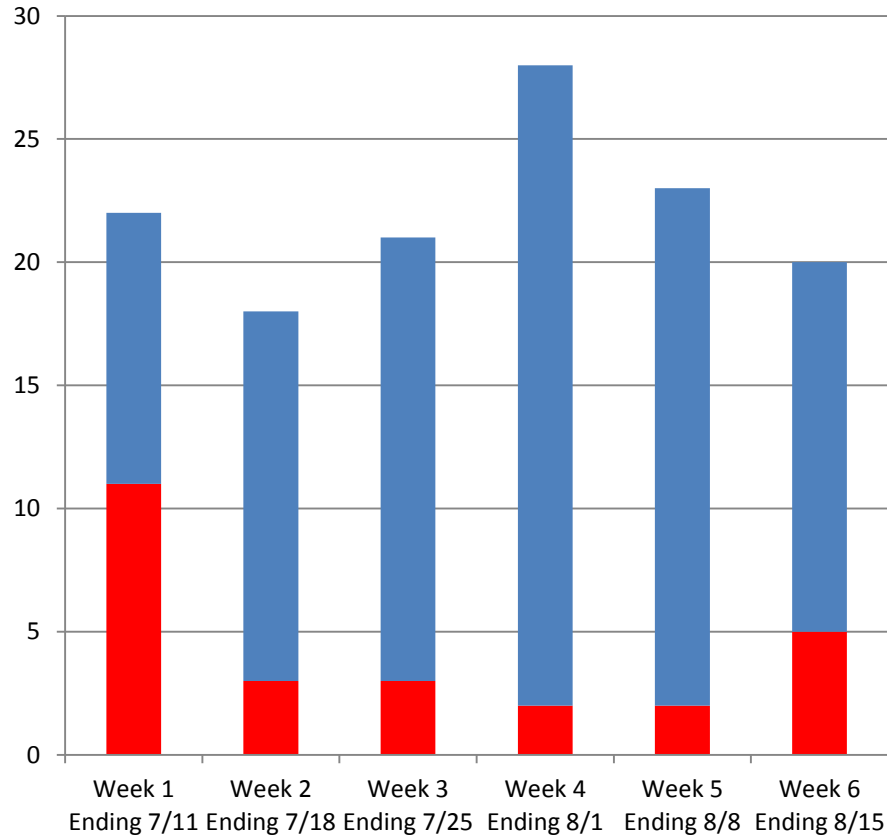

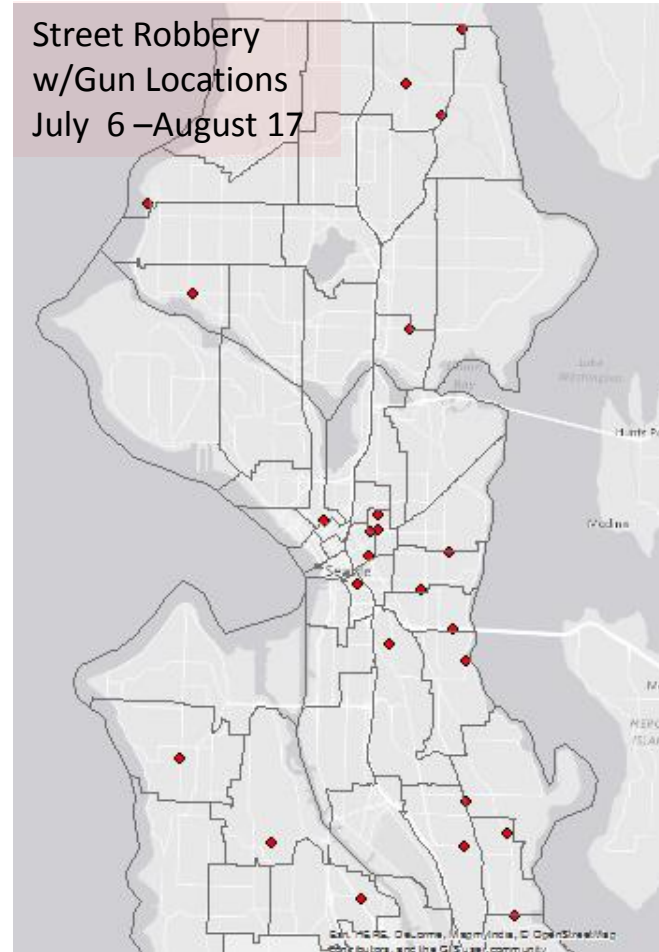

## Street Robbery City Wide



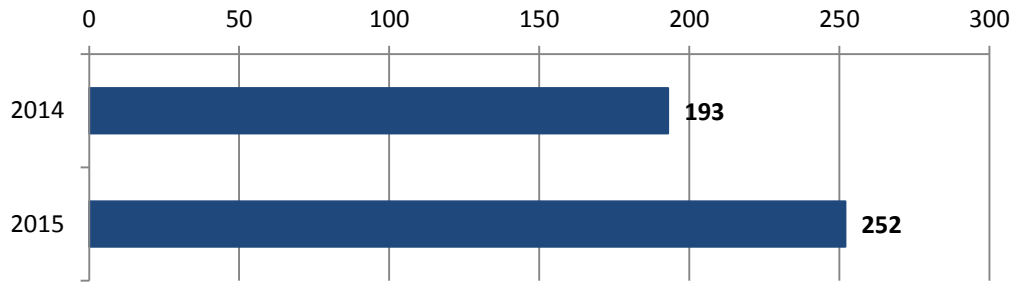
## Street Robbery w/Gun Locations July 6 – August 17



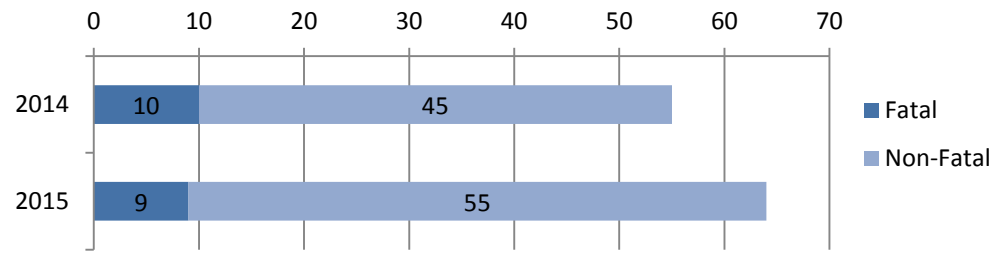

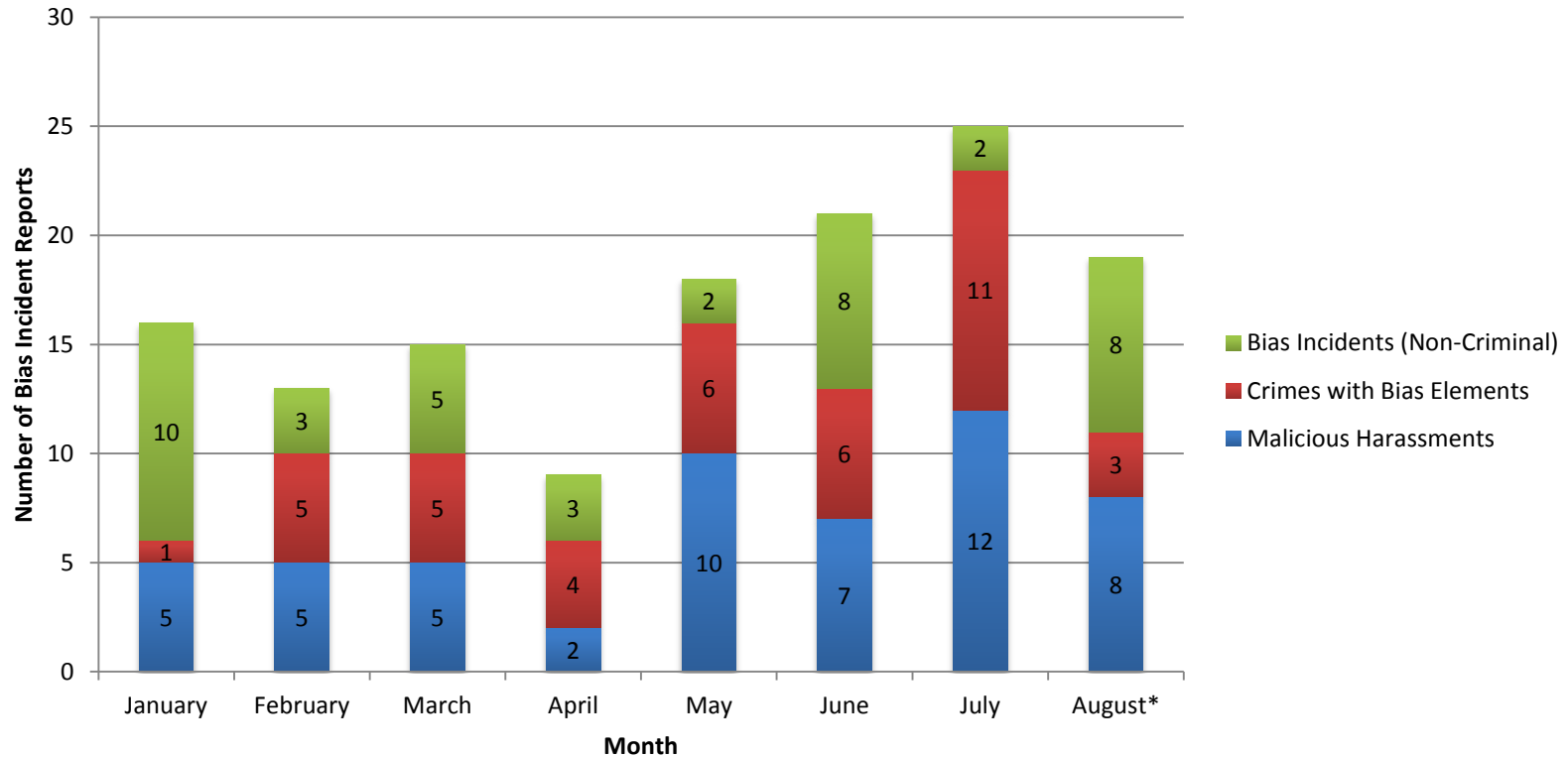
