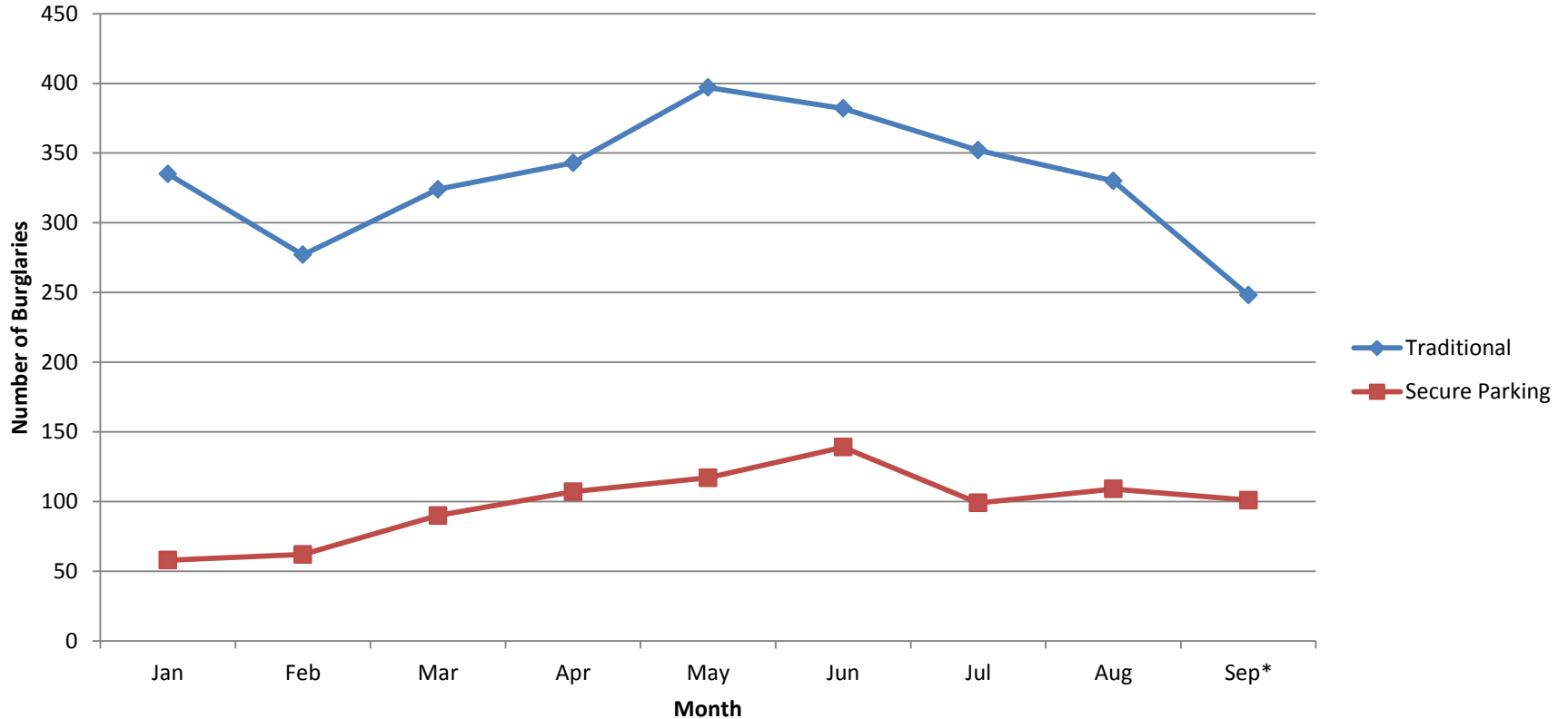

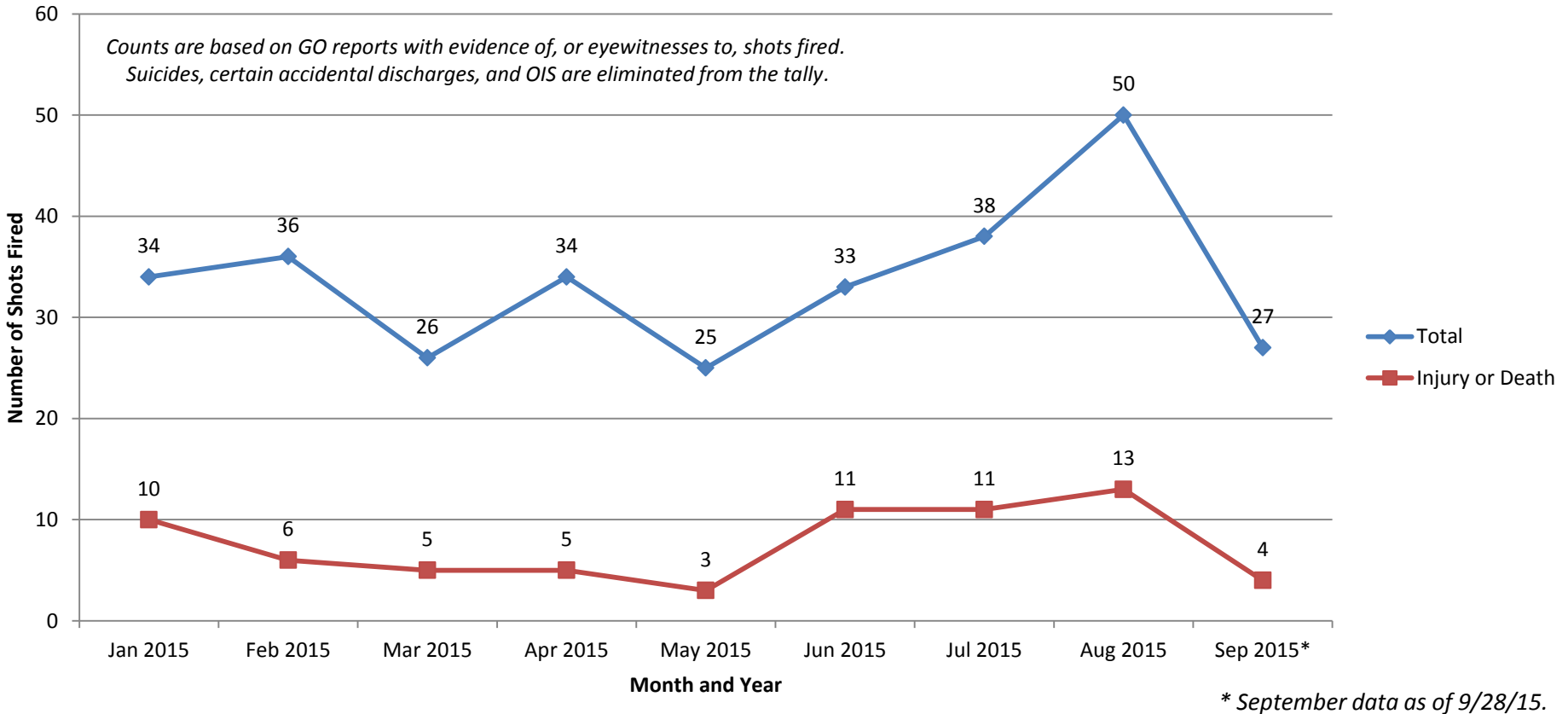

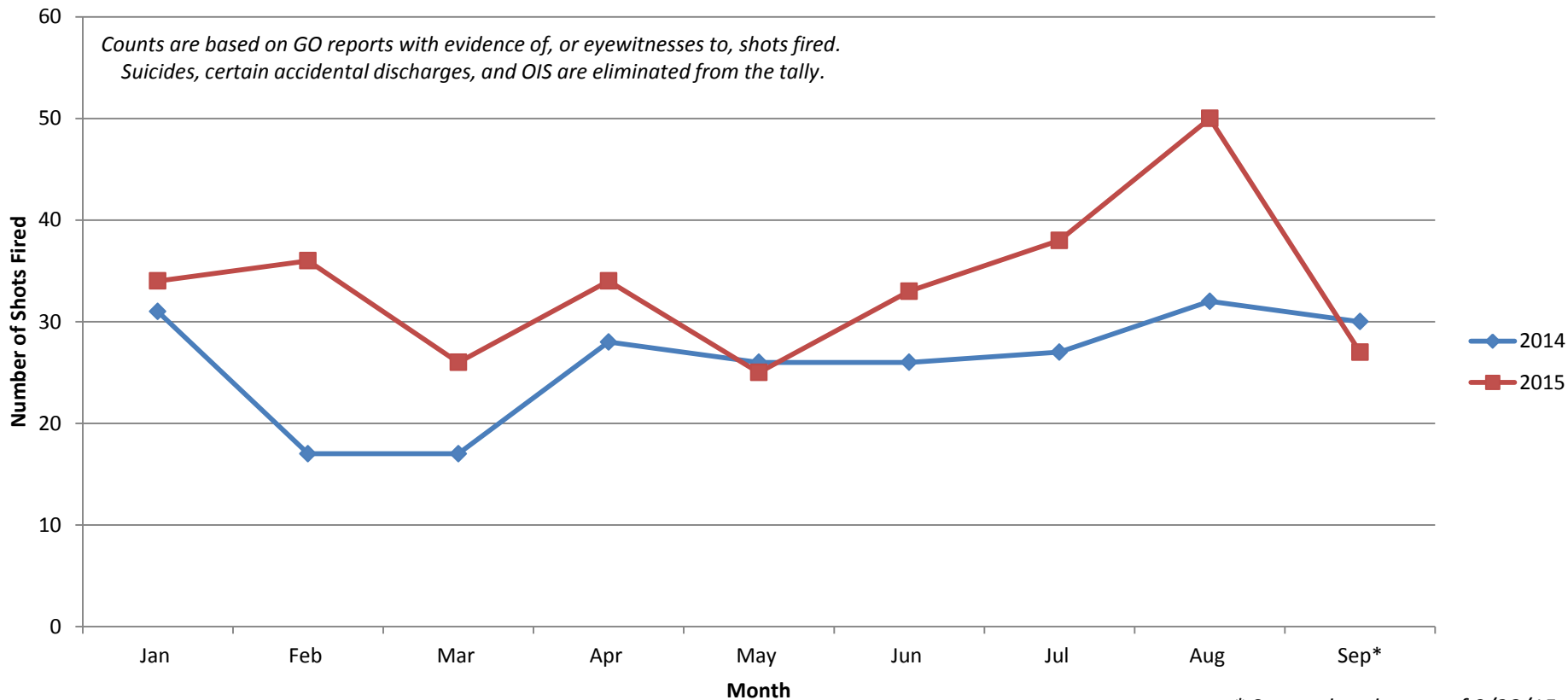

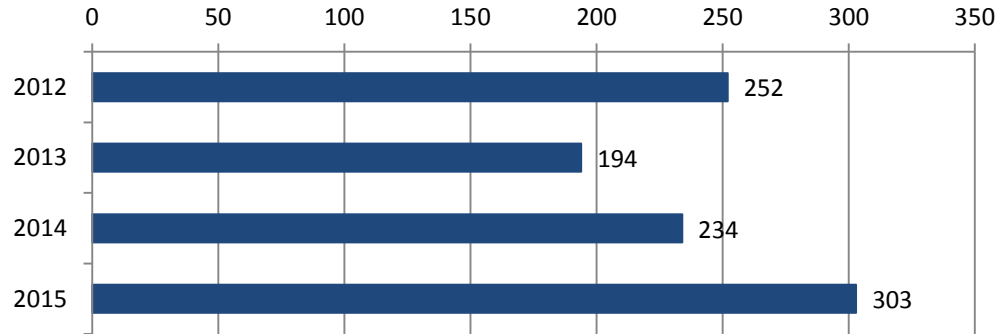
2014 and 2015 Shots Fired by Month



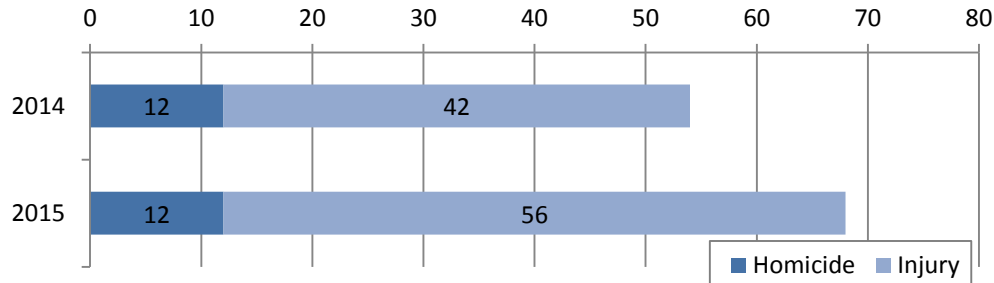

January 1 to September 28 (2014 and 2015)

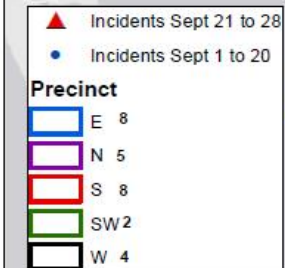
