- Register to attend through the Zoom link provided for the meeting.
- During the meeting, the Chair will ask the public to use the Raise Hand function to be added to the public comment list. To use the Raise Hand function:
 - Online/Desktop App Users
 - Click the Participants button that sits at the bottom right corner of the window
 - Click on the hand icon that sits at the bottom of the menu next to the Share function
 - Click **Raise hand**  in the webinar controls. The host will be notified that you've raised your hand.
 - **Windows:** You can also use the Alt+Y keyboard shortcut to raise or lower your hand.
 - **Mac:** You can also use the Option+Y keyboard shortcut to raise or lower your hand.
 - Mobile App Users
 - Click the Participants button that sits at the top right corner of the window
 - Click Raise Hand that sits at the bottom right corner of the Participants List
 - Call-in Users
 - Press *3 to raise your hand
