About SCERS

The Seattle City Employees' Retirement System (SCERS) is a defined benefit plan, providing retirement income to thousands of former City of Seattle employees and their beneficiaries. SCERS currently serves over 20,000 members across active employee members, retirees or their beneficiaries, and deferred members. SCERS also stewards an investment portfolio of over \$4 billion in assets for the benefit of our members. SCERS is governed by a seven-member Board of Administration.

Investment Advisory Committee (IAC)

Seattle City Employees' Retirement System (SCERS) has established an Investment Advisory Committee to assist the Board of Administration in its investment functions and as required under state law. Members of the Investment Advisory Committee must be experienced and qualified in the field of investments.

IAC Responsibilities

Responsibilities shall include the following:

- Meetings with the Investment Committee Members are expected to attend the February, May, August and November Investment Committee meetings to review SCERS's investment performance for the prior quarter and conduct any other Investment Committee business. Investment Advisory Committee members are also welcome to join other Investment Committee meetings, particularly if an agenda item is within their area of expertise.
- Preparation of Annual Report The Investment Advisory Committee will also work with SCERS Staff to review the Committee's activities including analysis and recommendations regarding SCERS's investment policies, practices and annual performance for the past year, and draft its annual report as required by state law.
- Ad Hoc Requests In addition to the items described above, Investment Advisory Committee members may be asked either collectively or individually to consult from time to time on specific matters, including investment proposals, policies and practices.
