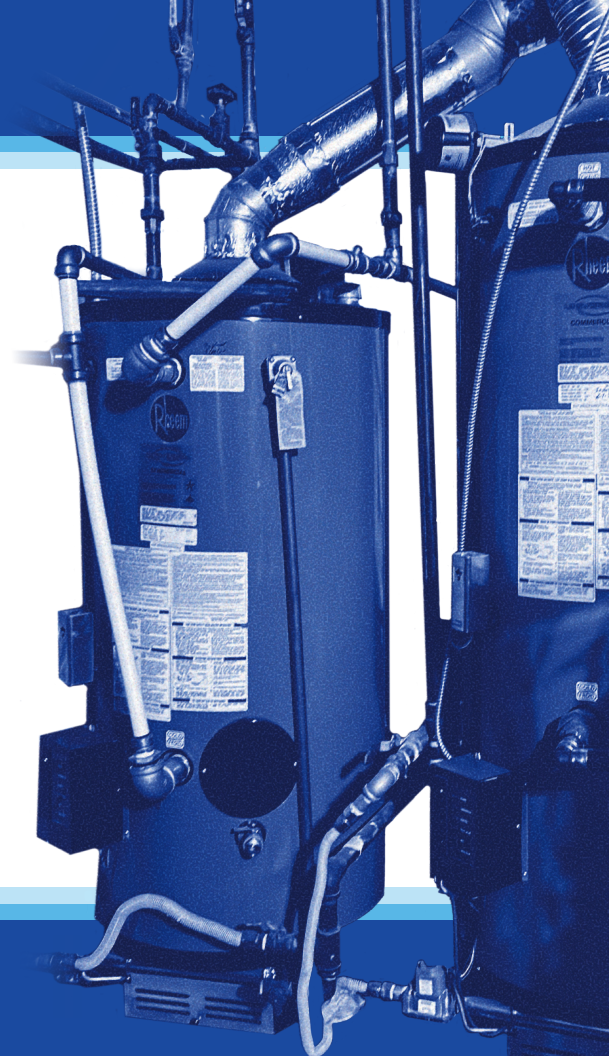


You're Required to Have an Inspection on Your Water Heater Every Two Years

Water heaters in public spaces such as restaurants, bars, health clubs, day care facilities and K-12 schools, and churches are required to be inspected biennially for everyone's safety. Incorrectly installed or maintained water heaters can be at risk of fire, explosion, or other hazards. Our inspections keep people safe by making sure relevant codes are followed.

How much does it cost?

There's a flat fee for water heater inspections.

Why should you do this?

It is unlawful to operate any water heater in A,E, or I occupancies without a valid Certificate of Inspection. You can avoid any legal fees and stop work orders by staying up to date with required inspections.
