

CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

Concrete and asphalt pavement repair work on 15th Ave S

WHAT'S HAPPENING

As soon as March 23, we will begin repairing segments of pavement or asphalt along 15th Ave S between Dr. Jose Rizal Bridge to Beacon Ave S at five locations:

- The east side of 15th Ave S just north of the 14th Ave S/15th Ave S/Golf Dr S intersection
- The northwest corner of 15th Ave S and S Holgate St
- The east side of 15th Ave S just south of the intersection with S Grand St
- The southeast and southwest corners of 15th Ave S and S Hill St
- The west side of 15th Ave S from S Bayview St to Beacon Ave S

WHAT YOU CAN EXPECT

We will work on one intersection at a time to minimize our footprint. Once construction begins, here's what you can expect:

- Work will begin as early as March 23, 2024
- Typical work hours are Monday Friday, from 7:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M.
- Each segment of work will take one to five days to complete
- Work is subject to changes based on crew availability and weather
- Temporary parking restrictions will be in place to make room for each work zone
- Temporary traffic revisions to accommodate construction vehicles and equipment
- Noisy work activities, such as backup alarms for safety, heavy vehicle use, and the use of power tools
- We anticipate this work will by complete by summer 2024

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

This work is part of the Beacon Ave S and 15th Ave S Safety Project that will make traveling in Beacon Hill more comfortable for everyone. This project will build safety improvements for all travelers by upgrading sidewalks and crossings, building accessible curb ramps, and implementing protected bike lanes. These changes will improve access to local destinations, transit, and the existing bike and trail network.


