Fall Service Change major details

- Metro service changes beginning on September 14
 - Major bus service restructure in Northwest King County
 - Launch of RapidRide G Line in the Madison Street area
 - New Northshore Metro Flex service in Lake Forest Park/Kenmore (Sep. 16)
- New Link 1 Line stations open August 30: Shoreline (148th & 185th), Mountlake Terrace, Lynnwood
- Northwest King County (North Seattle, Shoreline/Lake Forest Park, Northshore/SR-522)
 - New routes: 61, 333, 365, Northshore Metro Flex
 - Adjusted routes: 28, 65, 303, 322, 331, 345, 346, 348
 - Deleted or Replaced routes: 20, 73, 301, 302, 304, 320, 330, 347
- **Central Seattle** (Downtown Seattle, First Hill, Capitol Hill, Central District, Madison Valley)
 - New routes: RapidRide G Line
 - Adjusted routes: 3, 4, 10, 11, 12, 49, 60, 101, 102, 125, 131, 132, 150
 - Deleted or Replaced routes: 16, 47, 64

New RapidRide G Line


- Significant investment along Madison Street
- Center stations, all-door boarding with dualsided, 5 door buses
- Pedestrian crossings near all stations
- Marion Street pedestrian bridge to connect from Ferry/Water taxi to G Line stop
- ORCA card readers next to all doors


Other Route Changes

• Extend Route 3

King County

METRO

- 30-minute service returns to Summit area; Queen Anne will not see change in service levels as original Route 3 trips to Queen Anne will be labeled as Route 4 trips
- Route 10 and 12 serve E Pine St and Pike Pine Corridor; 10-minute service on combined corridors, 20 minutes on other parts of the route
- **Route 11** serves E John St and Capitol Hill Link light rail (20-minute service)
- Route 49 reduced to 20-minute service level
- **Route 60** increased frequency, 12 minutes during weekday midday, and 15 minutes on weekends; 30 minutes all other times



Lynnwood Link Connections overview




- Increased east-west connections







Metro Flex Northshore

- North Kenmore, Brier, Lake Forest Park, Mountlake Terrace
- Neighborhood on-demand transit in area that can't be served by fixed-route buses
- Improves cross-county travel (~35% in Snohomish County)
- Monday-Friday, 7am-7pm
- Can connect to Metro Flex Juanita at Kenmore P&R


