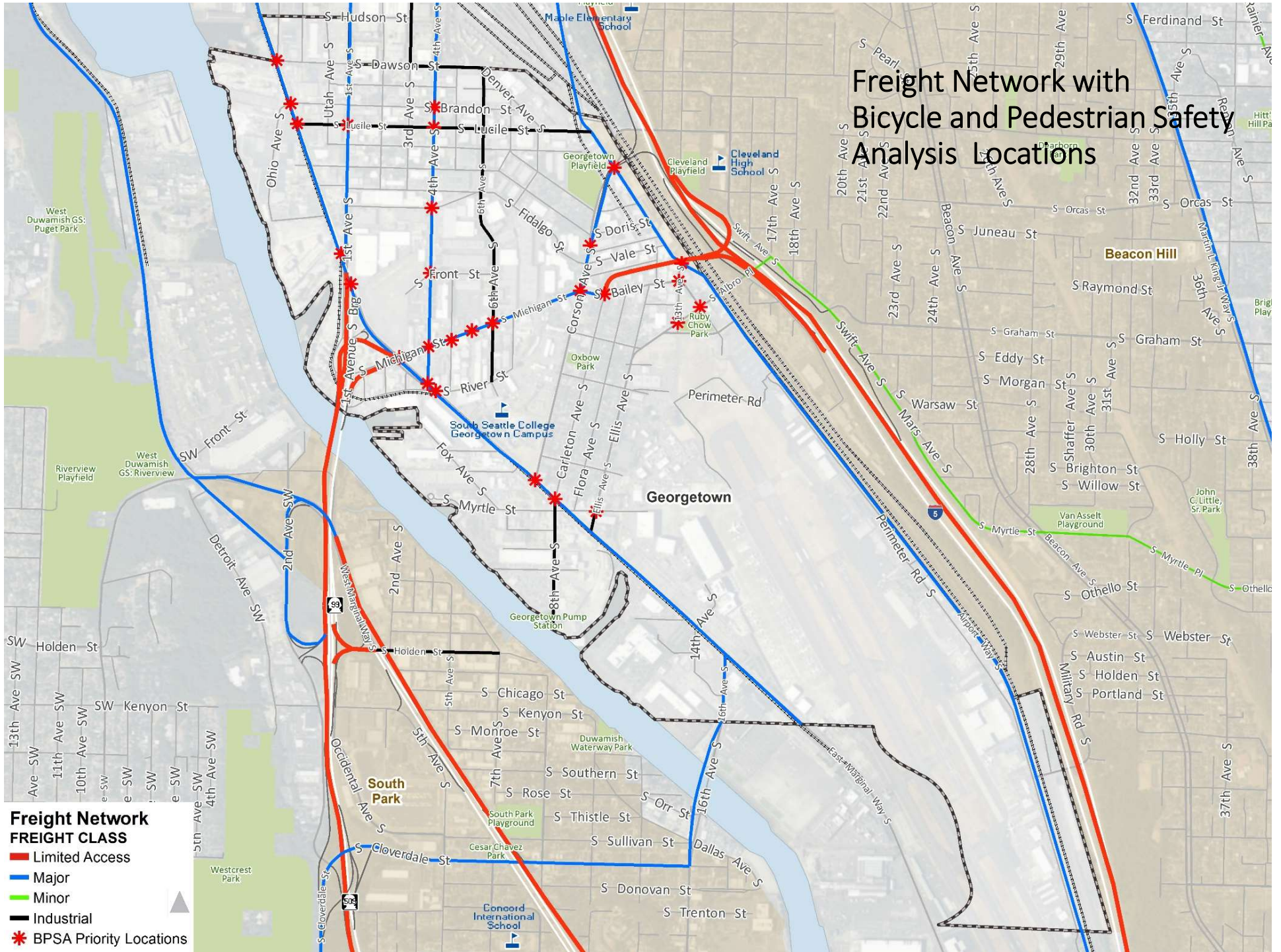

# Freight Network with Bicycle and Pedestrian Safety Analysis Locations

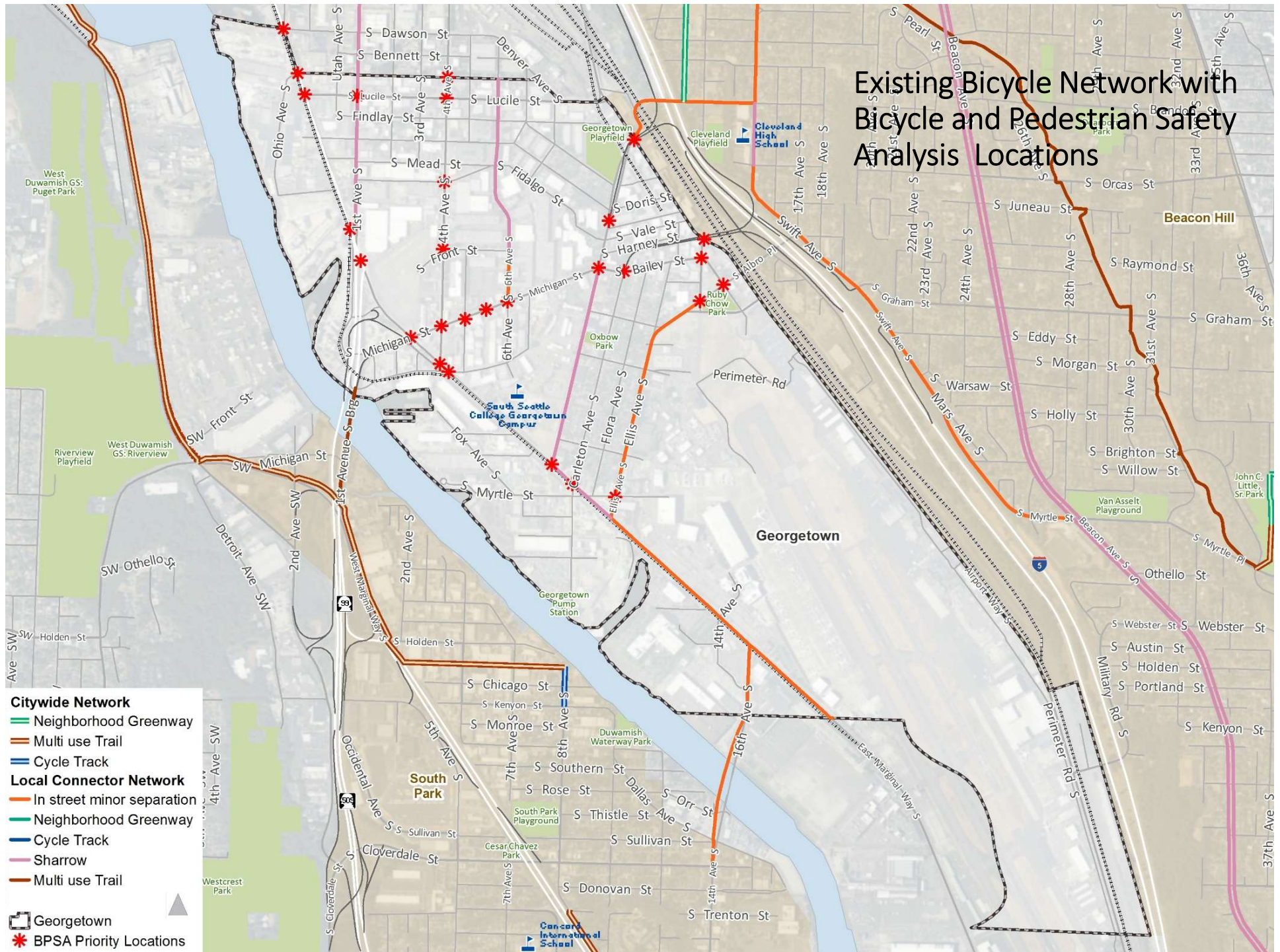








# Existing Bicycle Network with Bicycle and Pedestrian Safety Analysis Locations
