What's a neighborhood greenway?

Neighborhood greenways are safer, calmer residential streets for you, your family, and neighbors.

We make people walking and biking the priority on residential streets.

Neighborhood greenways can include:

- 20 mph speed limit signs
- speed humps to calm traffic
- stop signs for side streets crossing the neighborhood greenway
- signs and pavement markings to help people find their way
- easier crossings of busy streets with crosswalks, flashing beacons, or traffic signals

MOST PROMISING ROUTE

We've been working with community members from West Seattle since summer 2016 to identify routes for a new north-south neighborhood greenway to be built in 2019.

Through community site visits, open houses, materials, an online survey, and direct communication

with community members, we received feedback about our route options for both the north and south ends of the neighborhood greenway.

We heard that the community would like calmer, safer, and flatter routes to get to popular destinations like the West Seattle Junction and Westwood Village.



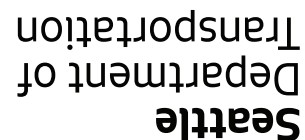

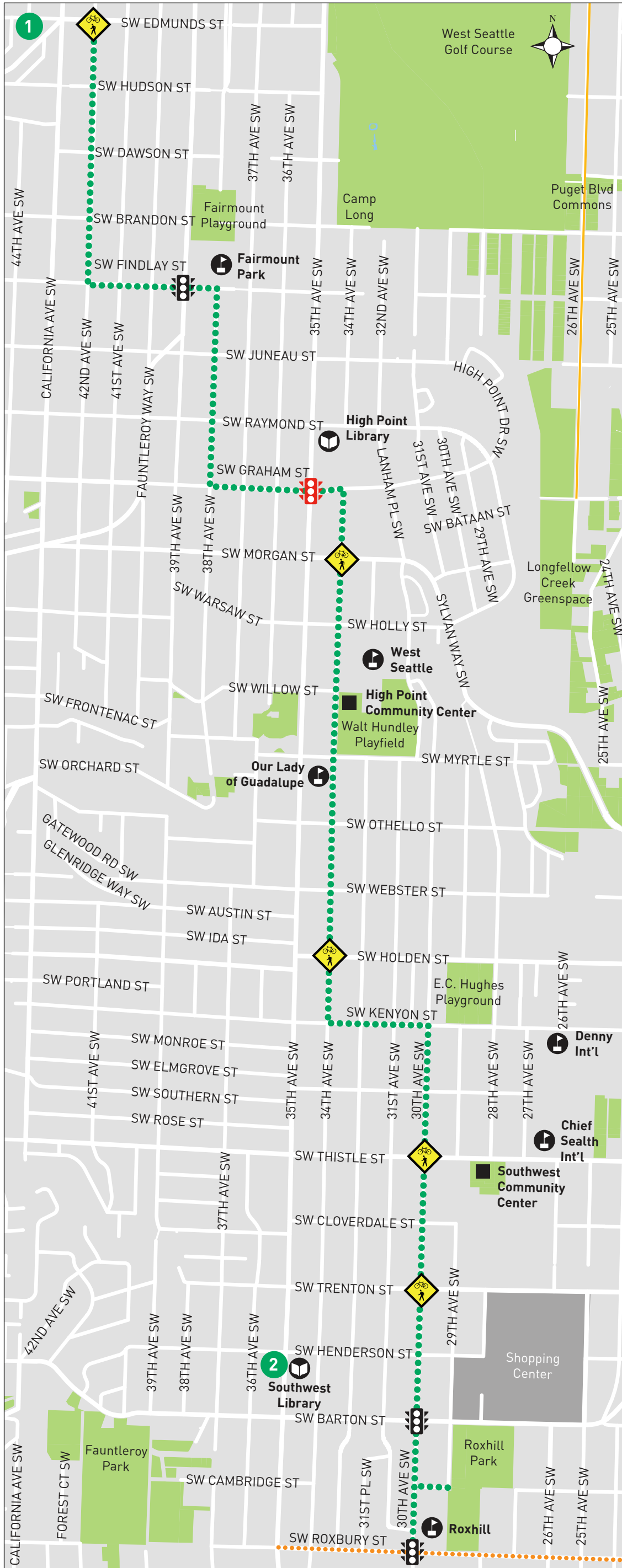
