



CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

July 2018

Upcoming construction on 35th Ave NE between NE 65th St and NE 89th St

Major construction is scheduled to begin **as early as Monday, August 6 in Zone C (see map on next page)**. Crews will repair sidewalks, replace curb ramps, and make street repairs on the east side of the street between NE 65th St and NE 89th St. Seattle Public Utilities currently has contractors working in this area to complete utility upgrades and complete minor sidewalk and pavement repairs.

Crews expect to start work on the east side of the street in the southern portion of Zone C, between NE 65th St and NE 70th St. Work will proceed north on the east side of the street several blocks at a time. When work is completed with the first section, a new work area will be established between NE 70th St and NE 75th St. When crews have completed work on the east side of the street, they will start working on the west side of the street. This work is expected to continue through the fall. Once this work is complete, crews will pave the street.

Northbound traffic impacts

- **Starting Monday, August 6, northbound 35th Ave NE will be closed with detours to 40th Ave NE from NE 65th St to NE 70th St (see map on next page)**
- Southbound traffic will be maintained
- Please follow signed detour routes and avoid cutting through neighborhood streets

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- **On-street parking near work areas on both sides of the street**
- **Northbound lane closed for several blocks at a time – use 40th Ave NE as detour**
- **Limited turns to and from side streets within active work areas**
- **Temporary bus stop closures and reroutes – check King County Metro’s website for details**
- **Closures at each work area are expected to last approximately three to four weeks**
- People walking will need to use temporary detours in select locations
- Pedestrian access maintained to homes and businesses at all times
- Construction noise, dust, and vibration
- Typical work hours from 7 AM to 7 PM, weekdays

Trimming tree limbs and plants

Reminder to property owners: any vegetation that hangs over the sidewalk as well as tree limbs that hang 14 feet or lower over the street need to be trimmed before Monday, August 6. Crews will need the space to complete sidewalk repair and move large equipment in the road. If plants are not pruned, our crews will trim them as work progresses.
