



Occidental Ave S Paving Project

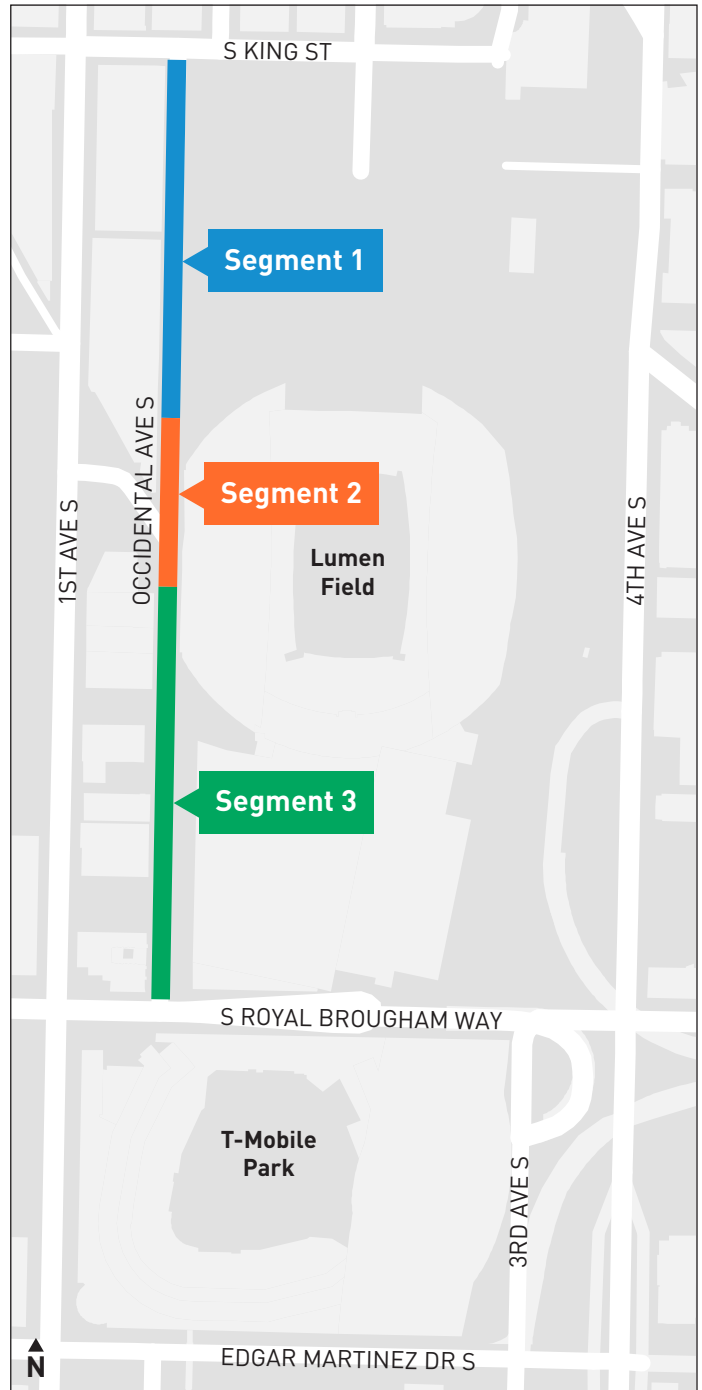
OVERVIEW

The Seattle Department of Transportation (SDOT) will pave Occidental Ave S, from S King St to S Royal Brougham Way. This work will resurface the road by milling and overlaying the existing asphalt. This work will begin in the northern segment at S King St. We will be coordinating the work with nearby events and vendors in the neighborhood and will complete the work in 3-4 segments. Work will not occur during major stadium events.

- Segment 1 – Scheduled for April 24 – May 5, 2023
- Segment 2 – Schedule TBD
- Segment 3 – Schedule TBD
- Segment 4 (if needed) – Schedule TBD

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- Total construction work along Occidental Ave S expected to last 2-3 months. Each segment will take approximately two weeks.
- Typical work hours between 8 AM and 3 PM, Monday through Friday. Some evening work may be expected.
- All work is subject to schedule changes and weather impacts.
- 24/7 parking restrictions for the duration of each segment will occur.
- Occidental Ave S will be closed to vehicles and pedestrians with road barricade signs.
- Temporary pedestrian and bike detours will be placed around the work zone and staging area. **Sidewalks will remain open and accessible around work zones.**
- Equipment will be staged inside the closure.
- Access to businesses and homes will be maintained at all times.
- Typical construction noise, dust, and vibrations will occur.
- Freshly paved surfaces will be hot to pets and humans, please do not walk on!
