



**Tree Removal Work- Final Notice  
Greenwood Ave N Sidewalk Project**

March 17, 2022

Dear Neighbor,

As you may know, the Seattle Department of Transportation (SDOT) is installing new sidewalks along Greenwood Ave N, between N 117<sup>th</sup> and N 125<sup>th</sup> St in the upcoming weeks. These new sidewalks will make it safer, easier and more pleasant to walk along Greenwood Ave N.

**As soon as 4/4/22 SDOT will begin removing and trimming trees adjacent to your property in order to clear the streets for the new pedestrian walkway.** During this process, you can expect:

- Approximately 49 new street trees will be planted as a part of this project
- All trees in the public right of way will be removed back to the property line
- All shrubs/hedges in the public right of way will be removed back to the property line
- All fences in the public right of way will be removed
- Temporary driveway restrictions. We will notify you two weeks in advance
- No park signs within active work zones on either side of Greenwood Ave N
- Typical work hours, from 8am to 4pm Monday through Friday
- Noise, dust and vibrations during work hours
- Mail and garbage collection will not be affected

**The trees to be removed will be posted with a placard from Urban Forestry at least 10 days before their removal. If you wish to salvage any of your trees or landscaping, please do so prior to the start of construction.**

We appreciate your support and patience with our construction work to make it easier to get around the neighborhood, and we hope you enjoy the completed project.
