CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

Alley Entrance from Highland Park Way SW Closed and Sidewalk Detours in Effect

WHAT'S HAPPENING

To increase safety and accessibility, we are rebuilding the sidewalk on the west side of Highland Park Way SW between SW Holden St and SW Portland St. As part of this work, we need to close and rebuild the entrance to the alley from Highland Park Way SW.

WHEN

The alley entrance is expected to be closed from August 31 – September 6. The sidewalk is currently closed, and it is scheduled to reopen by September 8.

WHAT TO EXPECT


All residents will need to use the alley entrance on 11th Ave SW during the closure. Also, if you are walking along Highland Park Way SW, please use the sidewalk on east side. There are crossings at SW Holden St and SW Kenyon St. (See map on the right.)

CONSTRUCTION NOISE

You have likely heard especially noisy work as our crews demolished the existing sidewalk. They use a chipping hammer to break up the concrete and it is very loud and generates vibrations. Most of that work is done, but there is a small section remaining, which will likely be demolished this week.
